

## get brit! LANGUAGE SCHOOL

The get brit! Language School project consists of a unique educational model through which 93% of the students who choose to certify their official level achieve it.

get brit! implements a unique management model, with a very important social focus, as it offers the possibility of language training to pupils from 3 years upwards, in any rural or urban area, at an affordable price, thanks to the collaboration of local councils and/or AMPA's, thus offering a comprehensive service to the entire educational community (teachers, pupils and families).

Both institutions are the fundamental pillar for get brit! to implement its method, as either the town council or the AMPA, provide a space in which to teach the classes, and therefore the price of the service is 29 €/month, with two weekly sessions of one hour each. There is a 29€ registration fee which members will not have to pay.

This is not an extracurricular activity, but a school in which students learn the language and also have the option of certifying their official level with Trinity or Cambridge in their own municipality. To this end, get brit! is responsible for accrediting the school as an official examination centre. Both certificates are valid internationally and do not expire.

get brit! offers training in several languages, including English, French, German, Italian, Chinese, Valencian and Spanish for foreigners. In our language schools, groups are established according to level and age. Students over 12 years of age are given a free level test and when pre-registering they are asked to mark their timetable incompatibility



in order to establish groups or timetables that favour the conciliation of family life. Groups are formed with a minimum of 5 and a maximum of 15 students.

We currently manage more than 100 Language Schools throughout Spain, with more than 10,000 students, with our own methodology and using books written by our teaching team and published and marketed by McMillan publishers.

Our teachers are professionals in language teaching, bilingual or native speakers trained to teach in their native language. The teaching structure is made up of a Director of Teaching supported by a team of coordinators or head of studies in each area.

In addition, activities related to language training are carried out, such as language immersions inside and outside Spain, urban or nature summer camps with the aim of improving the language in environments other than the classroom.

It also has a department dedicated to in-company training in different formats (group by status, one-to-one, in-company, face-to-face or virtual), as well as translations of web pages or interpreting at events.
