2nd Meeting: Spain March 2019

LEARNING, TEACHING AND TRAINING ACTIVITIES

1st Day

The participating schools met for the second time in Spain. The meeting was attended by students and teachers from Estonia, Turkey and Bulgaria (3 teachers and 2 students each one) and from Italy (2 teachers and 3 students).

The Spanish team, as host country, made a great effort to make the other countries members feel like at home.

The entire Lope de Vega school together with teachers and students received our guests the 1st day in the schoolyard with the flags of the different countries and saying hello in their own languages.

The welcome party continued with a "dança", the traditional dance of the Valencian community. Then, the Extracurricular group of our school delighted us with a dance related to the dreams we can achieve if we propose them, as in our project "We dream of saving our planet all together".

We gave all the member countries of the project a typical handkerchief "mocador" and the bracelet of the bravest students of our school.



After a short break, Mr. Antony with Pilar (principal), Susana and Charo, showed the different facilities of the educational center and explained how the whole Erasmus project "SERA" is changing our school.



The morning continued with a gymkhana of traditional games including valencian ball prepared for the students of 5th and 6th grade and the students of the other countries. We

finished the morning with a visual story presented by Mr.Rafa in which we could also enjoy a quizz game in teams using "Kahoot" (with tablets) in relation to the visual story about environmental issues.



After having lunch, the different countries members showed their presentations in order to explain how SERA is changing their schools as well.

In the afternoon we visited the Tower of Torrent and the central market where we could see the exhibition of puppets made of cork and cardboard (Fallas)



2nd Day

We went by bus to the "Albufera Natural Park" where we enjoyed a magnificent boat trip observing its ecosystem, later we went through the Saler dunes (looking up the different ecosystems as well) to end up at the beach enjoying the sea.



In the afternoon we visited the gardens of the old river Turia in Valencia and we walked down until we reached Gulliver Park where the children had a great time throwing themselves by the slides that are part of Gulliver, the main character of a fantastic book.



3rd Day

SIGHTSEEING TOUR TO THE TOWN CENTER:

Before Lunch:

1. Arrival at the subway station (COLON)
2. Visit to the Parterre Park with James I, The First equestrian statue and its thousand year old trees.
3. Walk along La Paz Street.
4. Visit to the Marqués de Dos Aguas Palace.
5. Walk along San Vicente street.

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6. Visit to the Central Market and Silk exchange.
 7. Return to San Vicente street to see “ La Mascletà”
 8. Barrio del Carmen : walk along Tossal square and Alta Street to arrive at the Maria Mandiles Restaurant (2’30 PM)

After Lunch:

1. Walk along Roterros Street to arrive at Serrano Towers.
2. Visit San Nicolas Church.
3. Visit the Virgin Square with its Fountain and The Basilica.
4. Visit the Cathedral and Miguelete (tower)
5. Walk along San Vicente Street to visit Round Square.
6. Visit City Hall Square.
7. Visit North Station and Bullring.



4th Day

The day began with a big poster that our school had prepared with the logos of the educational institutions and large green footprints, where each of the participants, teachers

and students left their fingerprints printed, as a symbol of union between the different countries of the Erasmus project.



After that, they could see how we placed all the puppets together to make a Falla, tasted the typical fallero breakfast "the Chocolata" and participated in "the globotà and mascletà sonora" directed by our music teacher.

At the end of the morning, our Falla , which had as main topic "Let's take care of our planet", was burned as part of our tradition.
