

TELLING THE TIME

Per a preguntar l'hora que és utilitzarem "What time is it?" o "What's the time?", i per a dir l'hora que és utilitzarem el següent quadro en el que entre parèntesis està el nombre corresponent a l'hora de l'exemple que canviaria:

MINUTS	EXEMPLE	
00	9:00	It's (nine) o'clock
15	10:15	It's quarter past (ten)
30	7:30	It's half past (seven)
45	12:45	It's quarter to (one)
1-29	11:07	It's (seven) past (eleven)
31-59	2:48	It's (twelve) to (three) -- (Mentalment es fa la resta 60 menys els minuts. 60-48=12)

IMPORTANT: No oblidar dir "It's" al respondre i practicar molt els nombres. Com a truc és bo recordar que primer es diuen els minuts i després les hores.

It's twenty to ... It's twenty past ...

It's twenty-five to ... It's twenty-five past ...

2:00 - It's two o'clock.	2:30 - It's half past two.
2:05 - It's five past two.	2:35 - It's twenty-five to three.
2:10 - It's ten past two.	2:40 - It's twenty to three.
2:15 - It's quarter past two.	2:45 - It's quarter to three.
2:20 - It's twenty past two.	2:50 - It's ten to three.
2:25 - It's twenty-five past two.	2:55 - It's five to three.

<p>We use AT + TIME when giving the time of a specific event.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The class starts at nine o'clock. - The flight leaves at ten to three. 	<p>We use IT IS or IT'S to answer a question that asks for the time right now.</p> <p>What time is it? - It is half past four.</p> <p>What's the time? - It's twenty to five.</p>
