a) Plants need water, soil, light and the proper temperature to grow

b) Personal answer

(They can't make their own food, and the plant will probably die)

c) The green substance found in plants is called chlorophyll. It captures sunlight.

d) Plants produce the gas oxygen when they make their food. Humans use oxygen to breathe.

a) The organs that protect the flower are the corolla and the calyx.

b) The part of the plant that turns into the seed is the ovule.

c) A flower's petals are colourful to attract insects to carry the pollen to other flowers.
