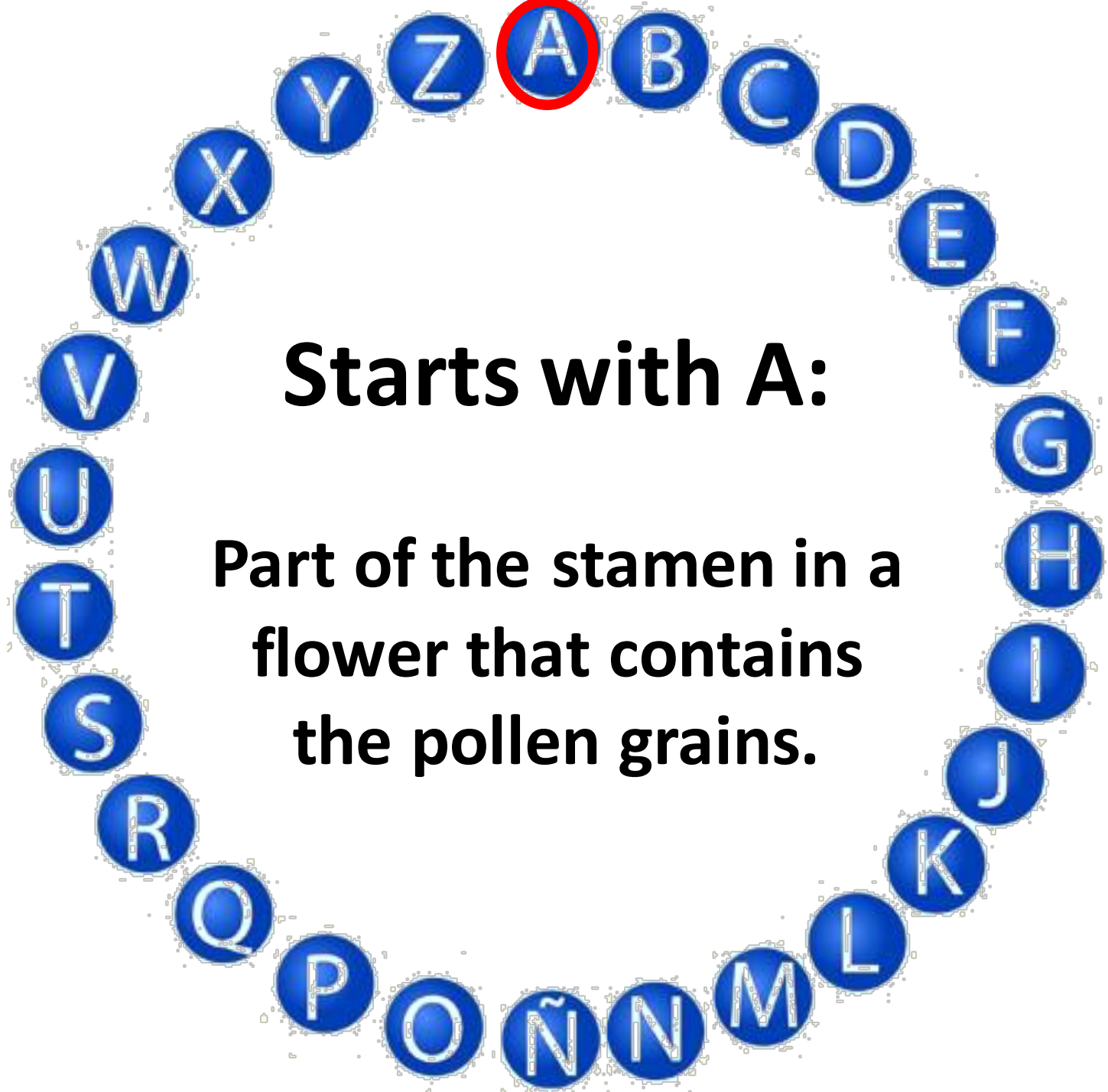

the pollen grains.**

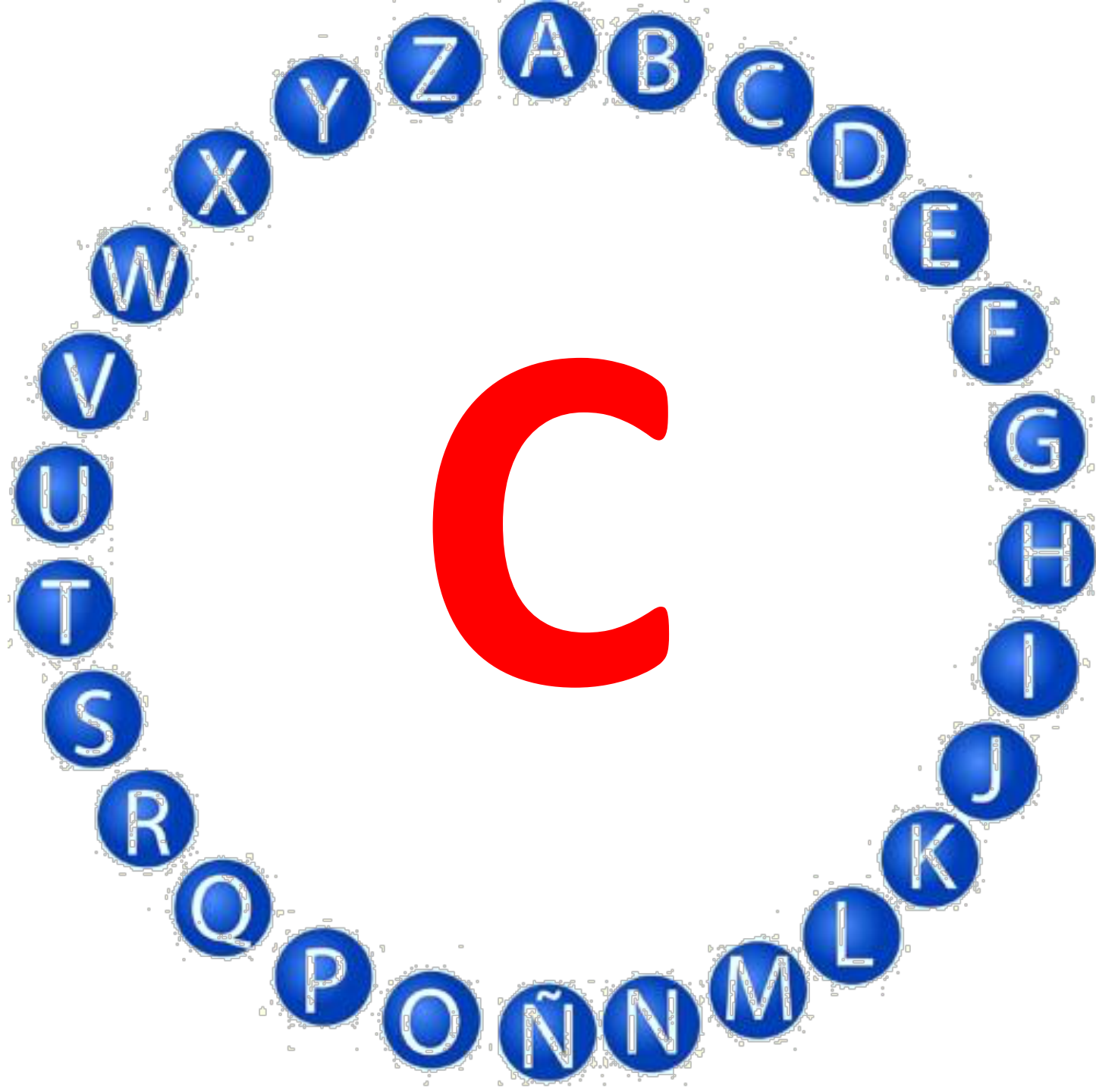


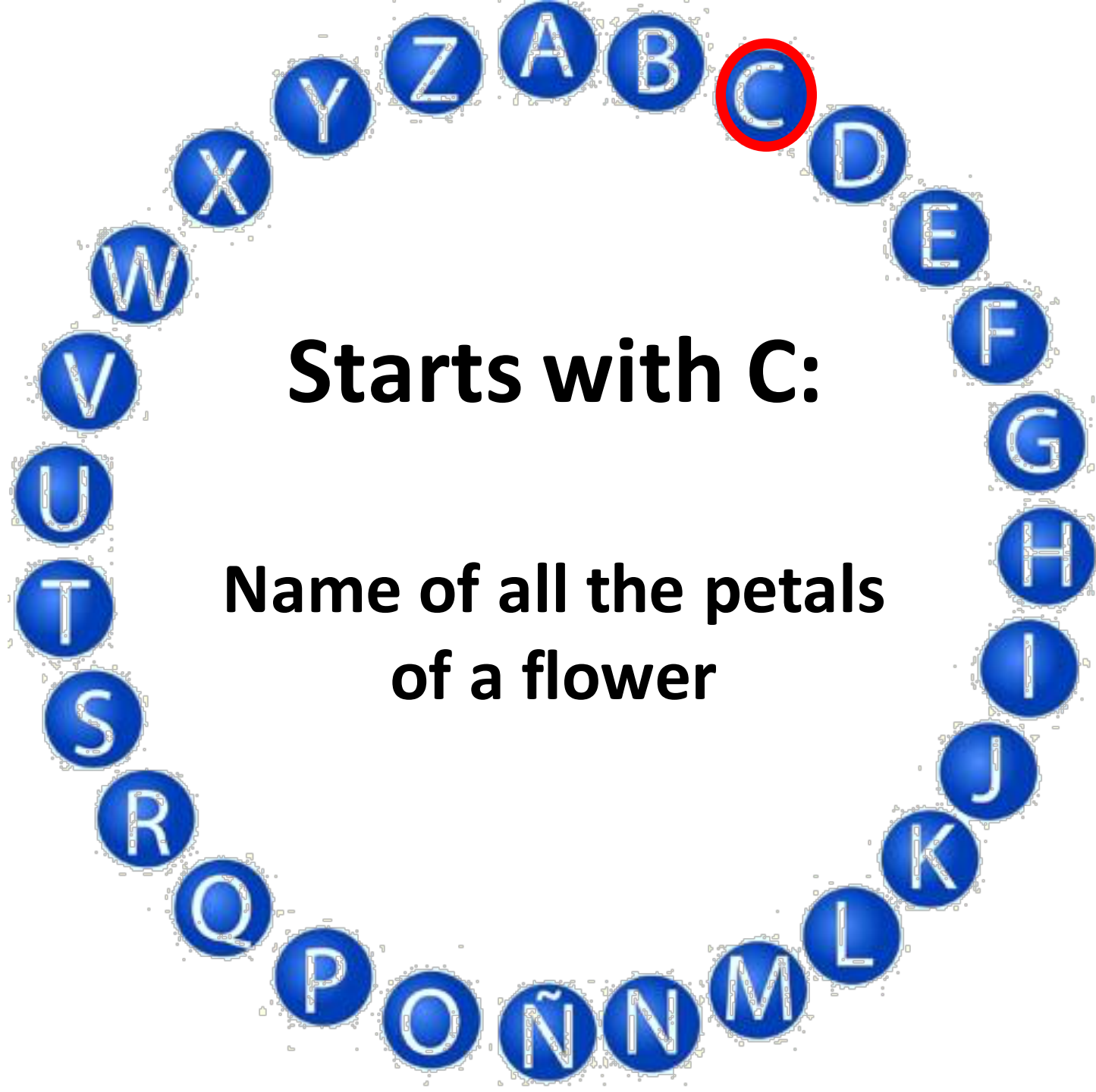




**Starts with B:**

of a flower**

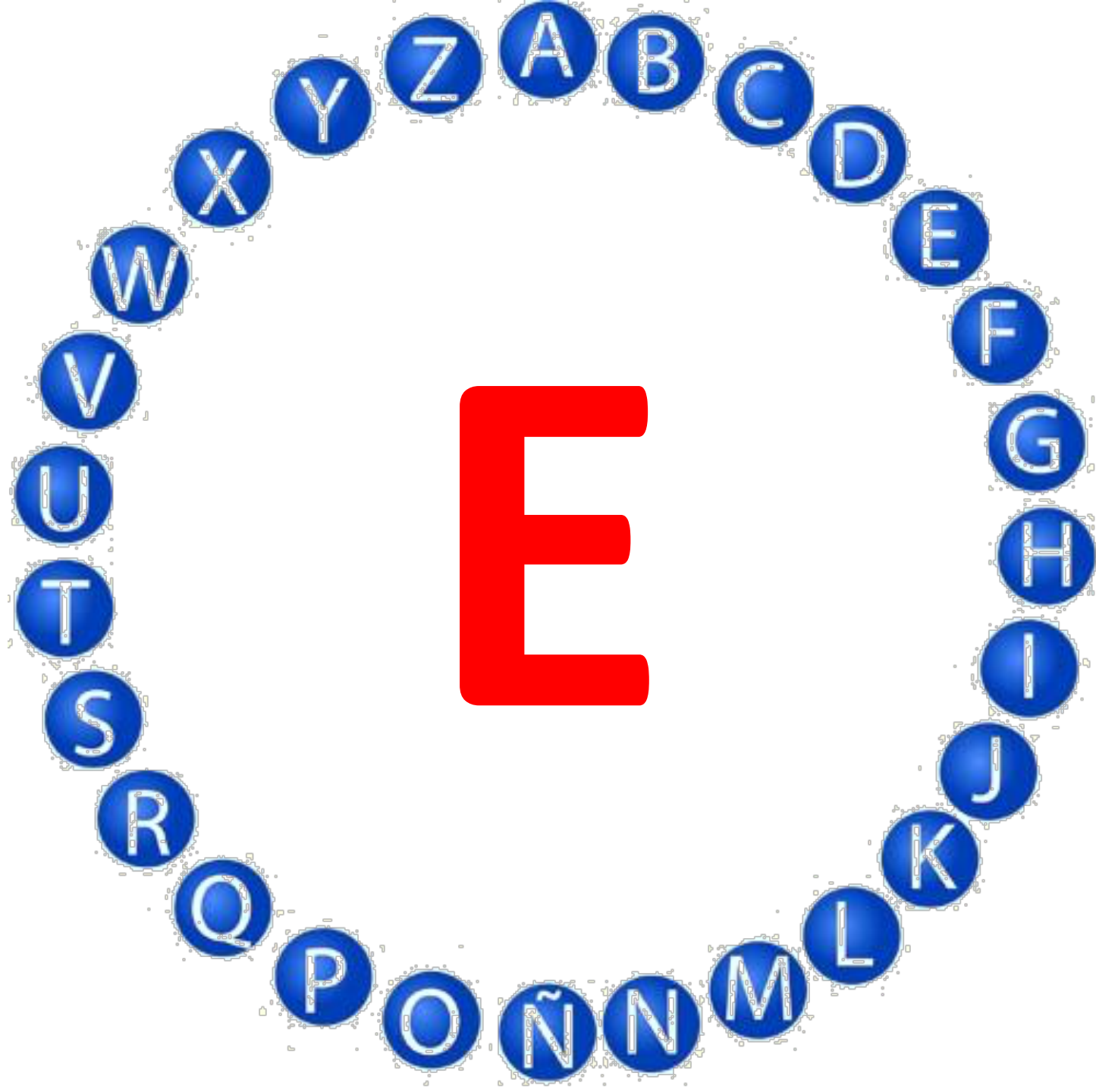


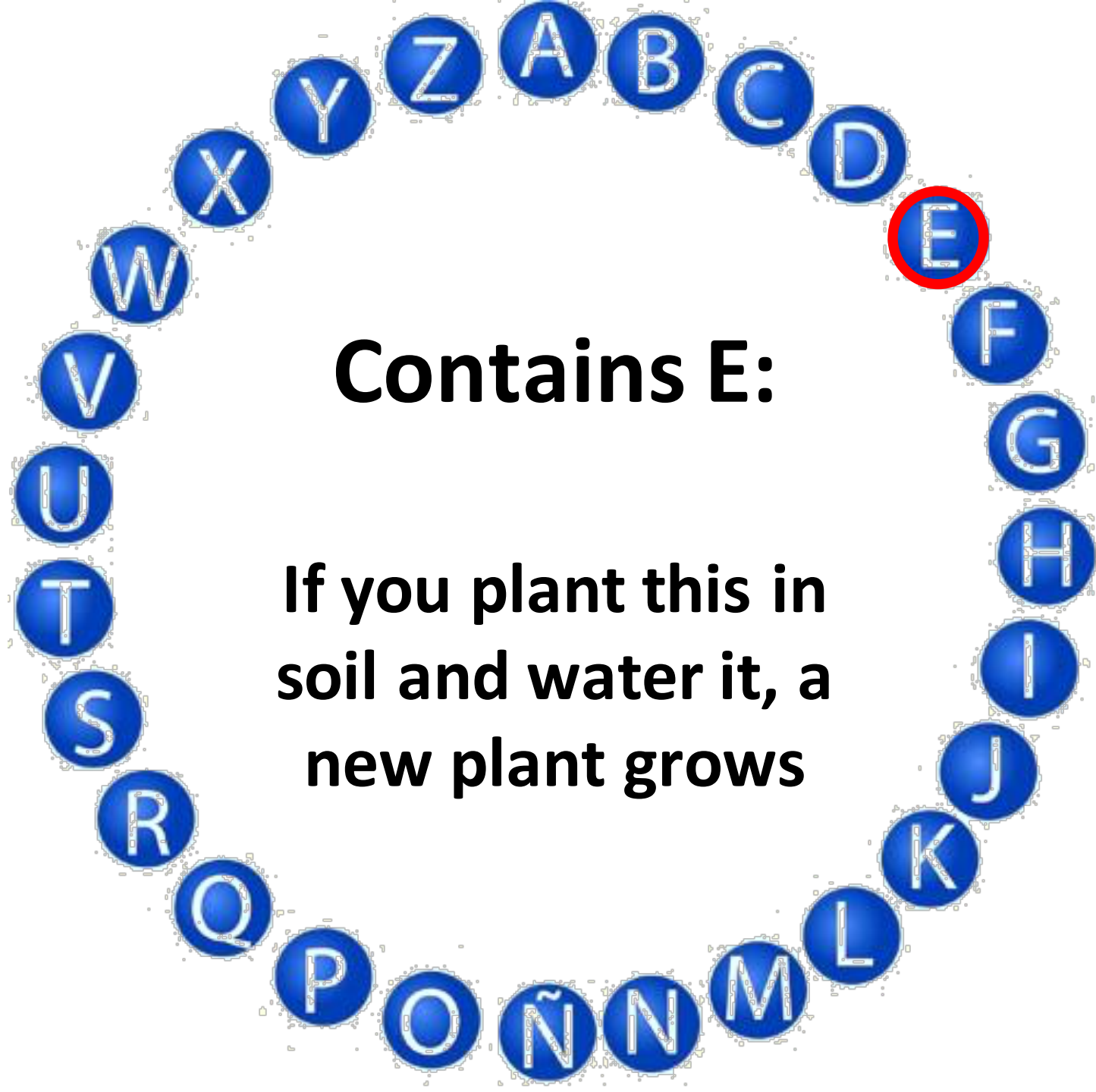




**Starts with D:**

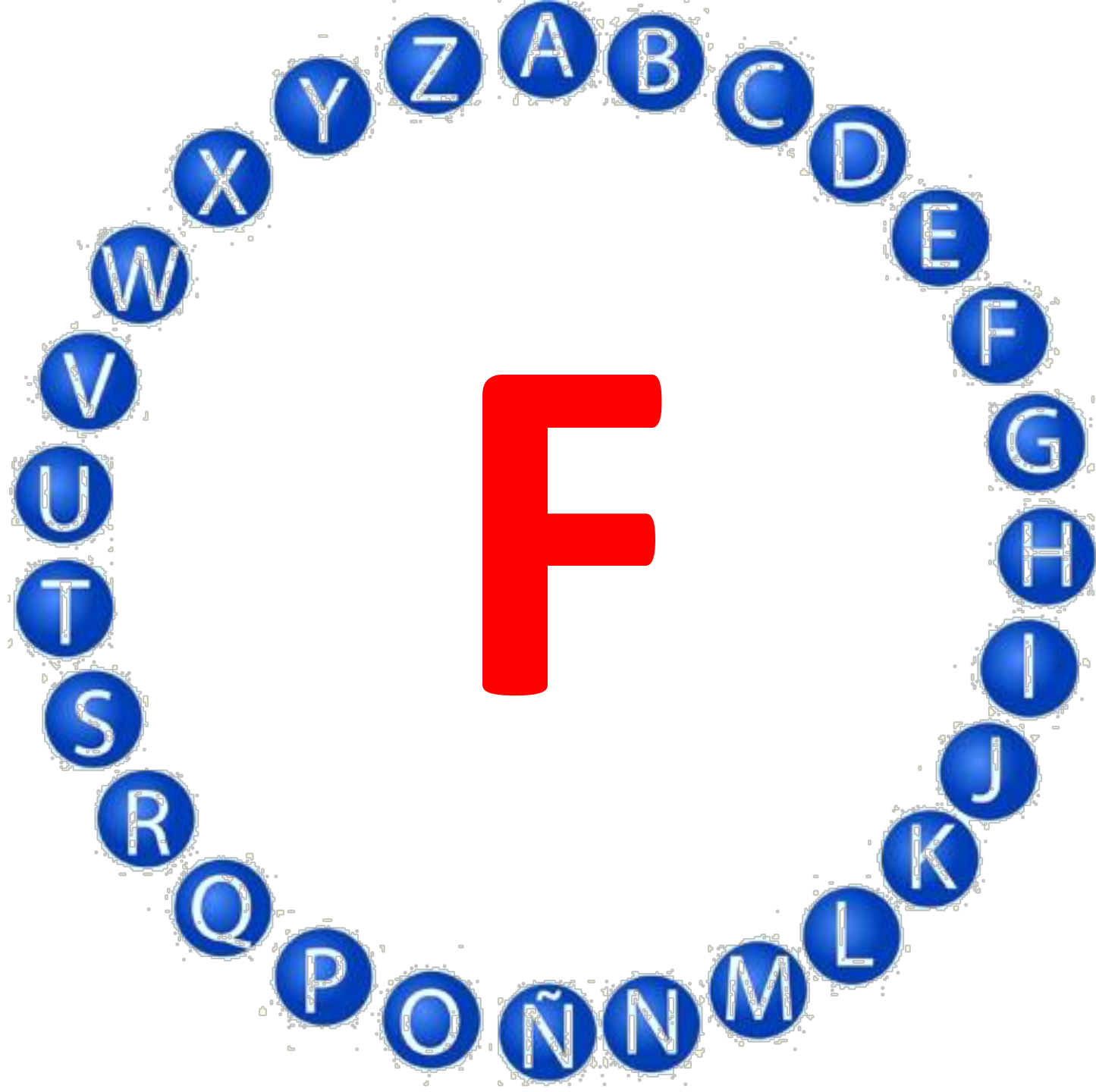
**Opposite adjective of

new plant grows**



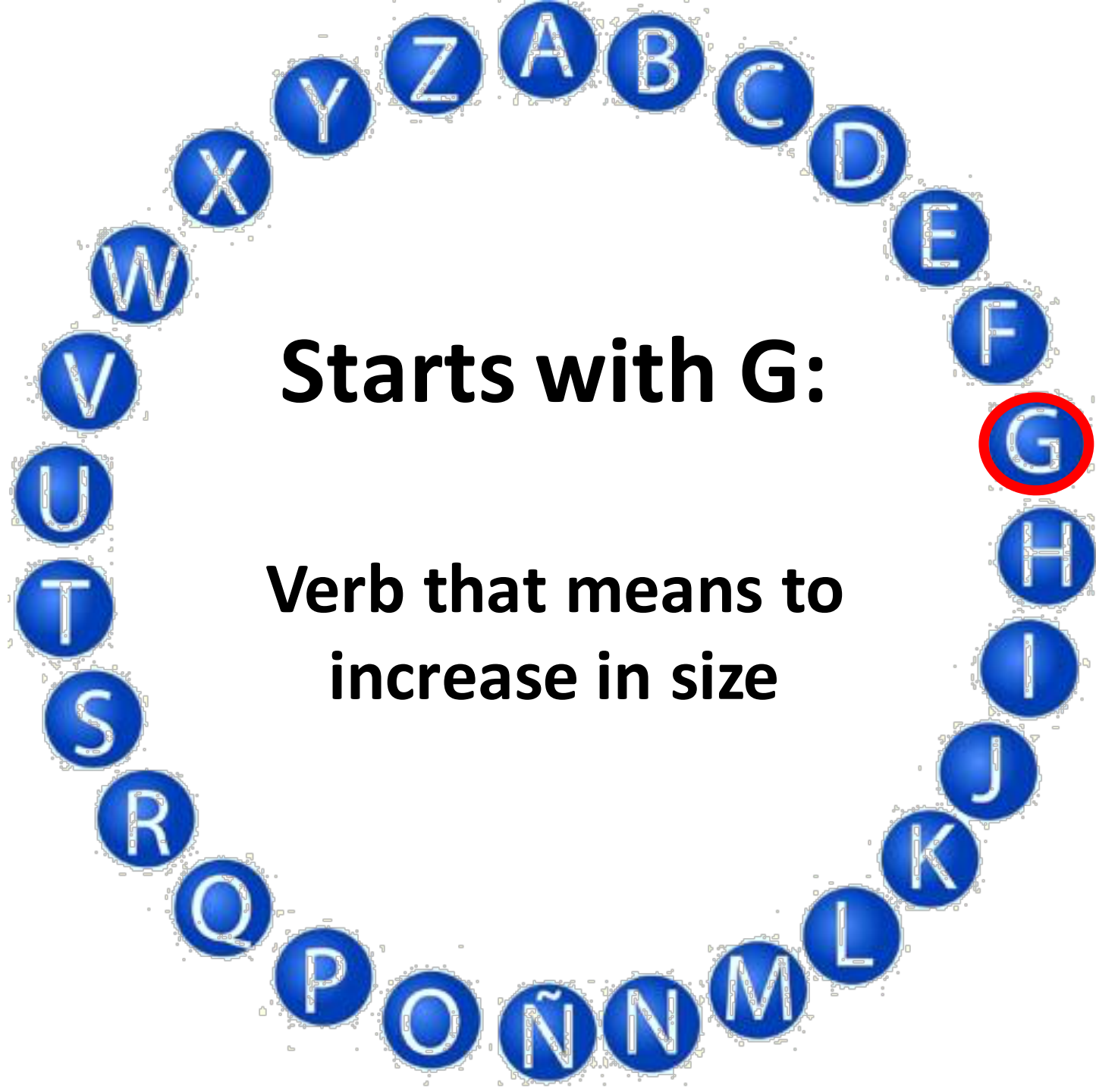


**Starts with F:**

agriculture or in a farm**

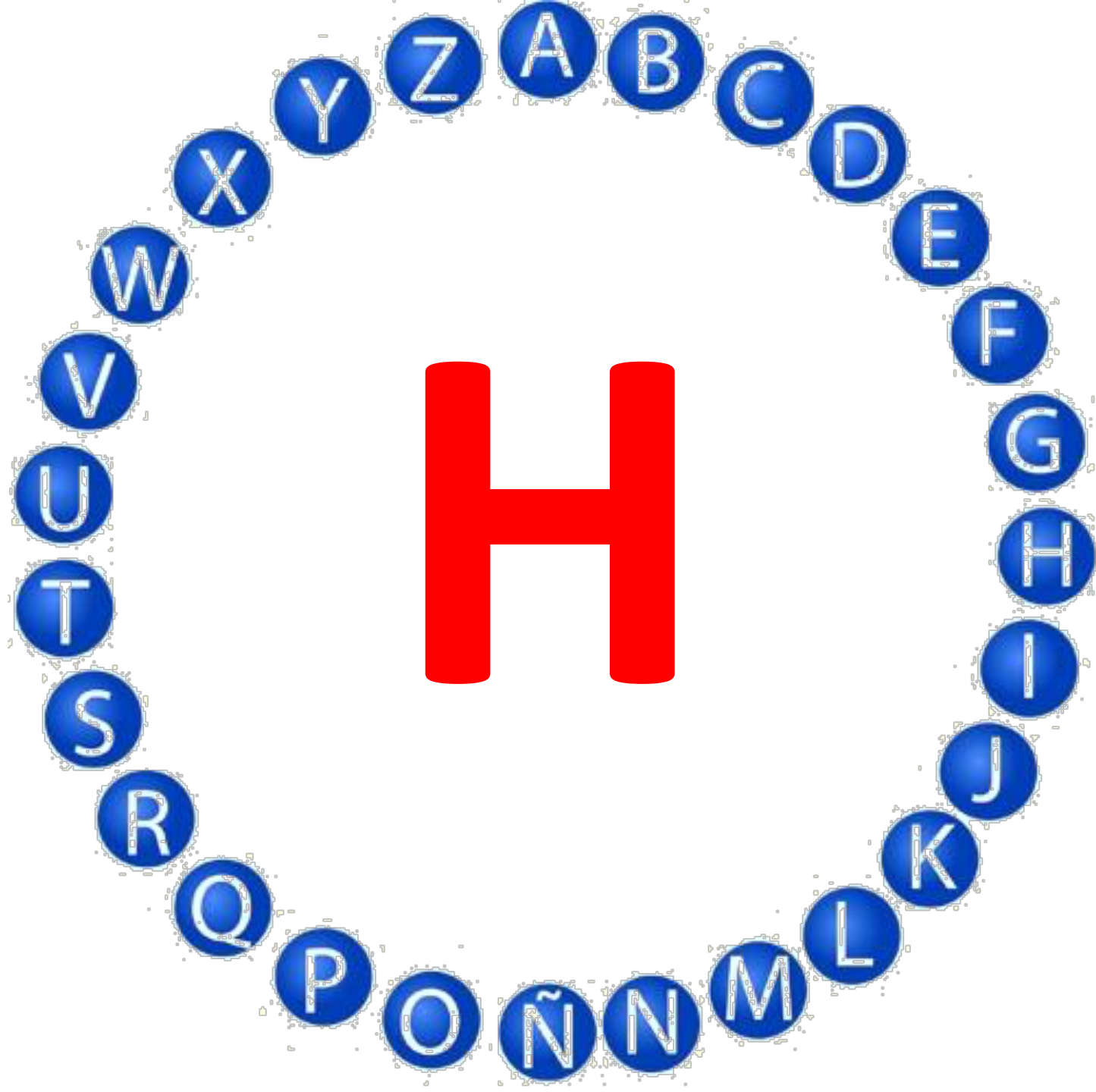






**Starts with G:**

plant grows.**

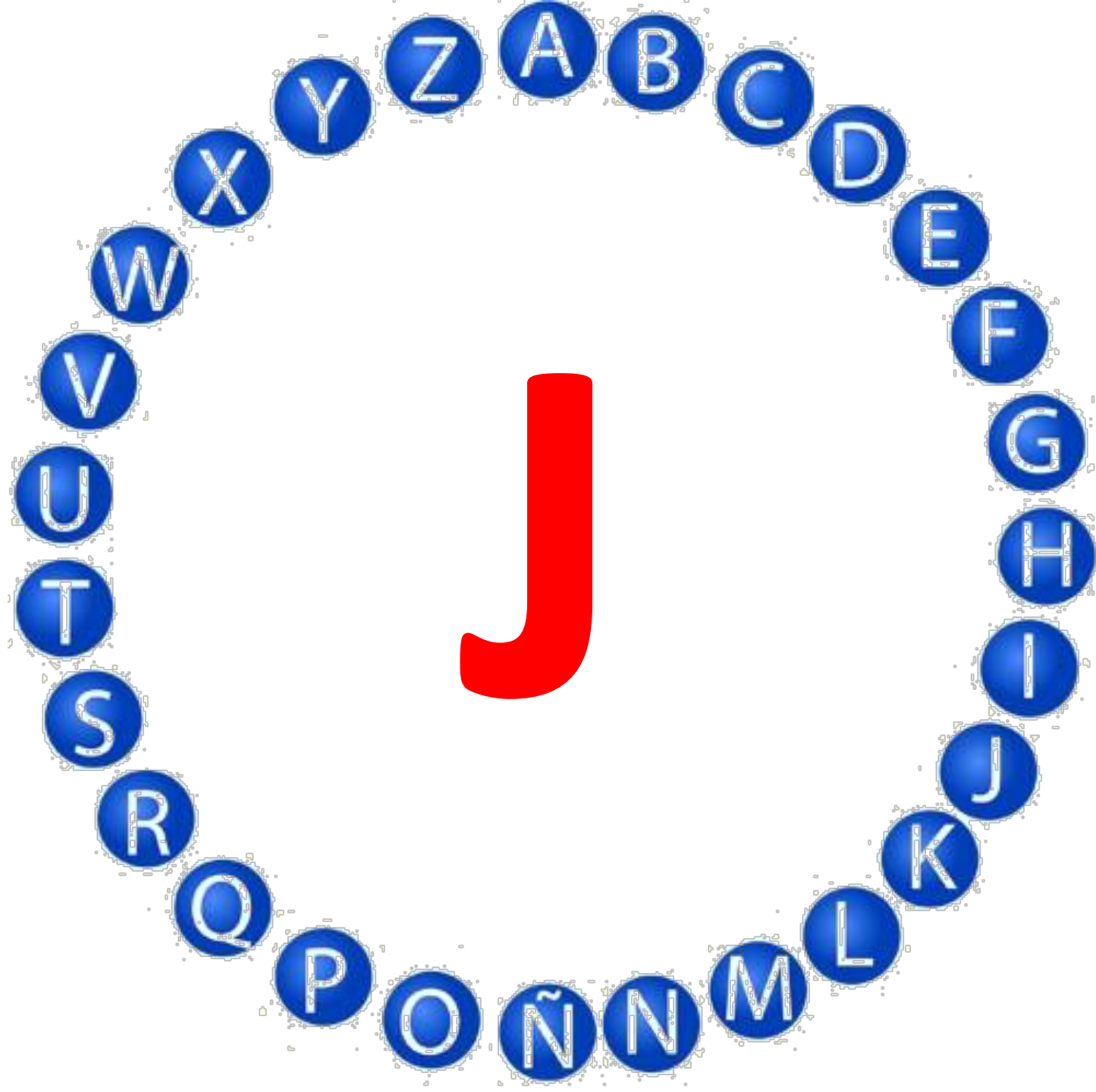






**Starts with I:**

water amount**

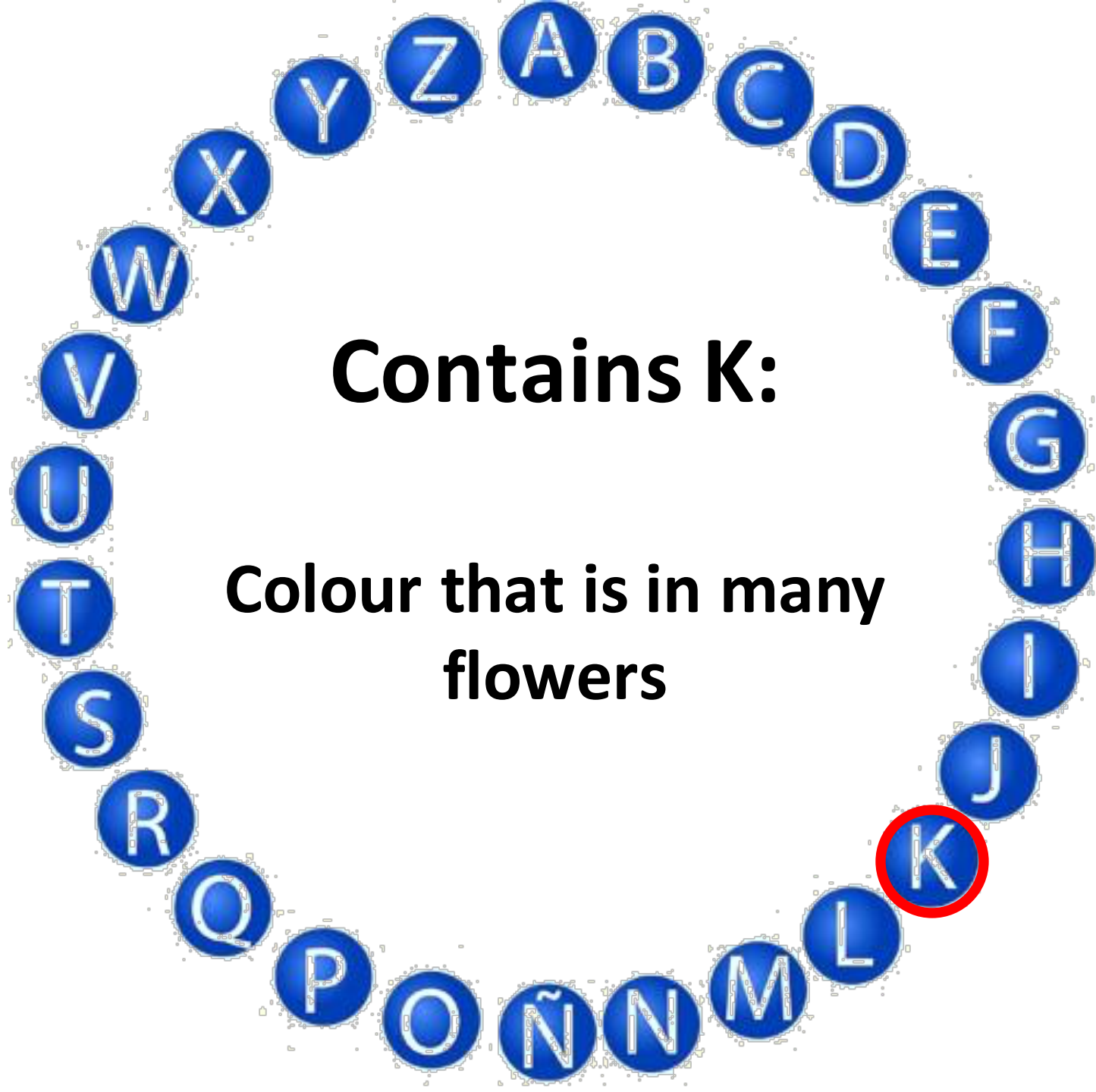




**Starts with J:**

make their own food**

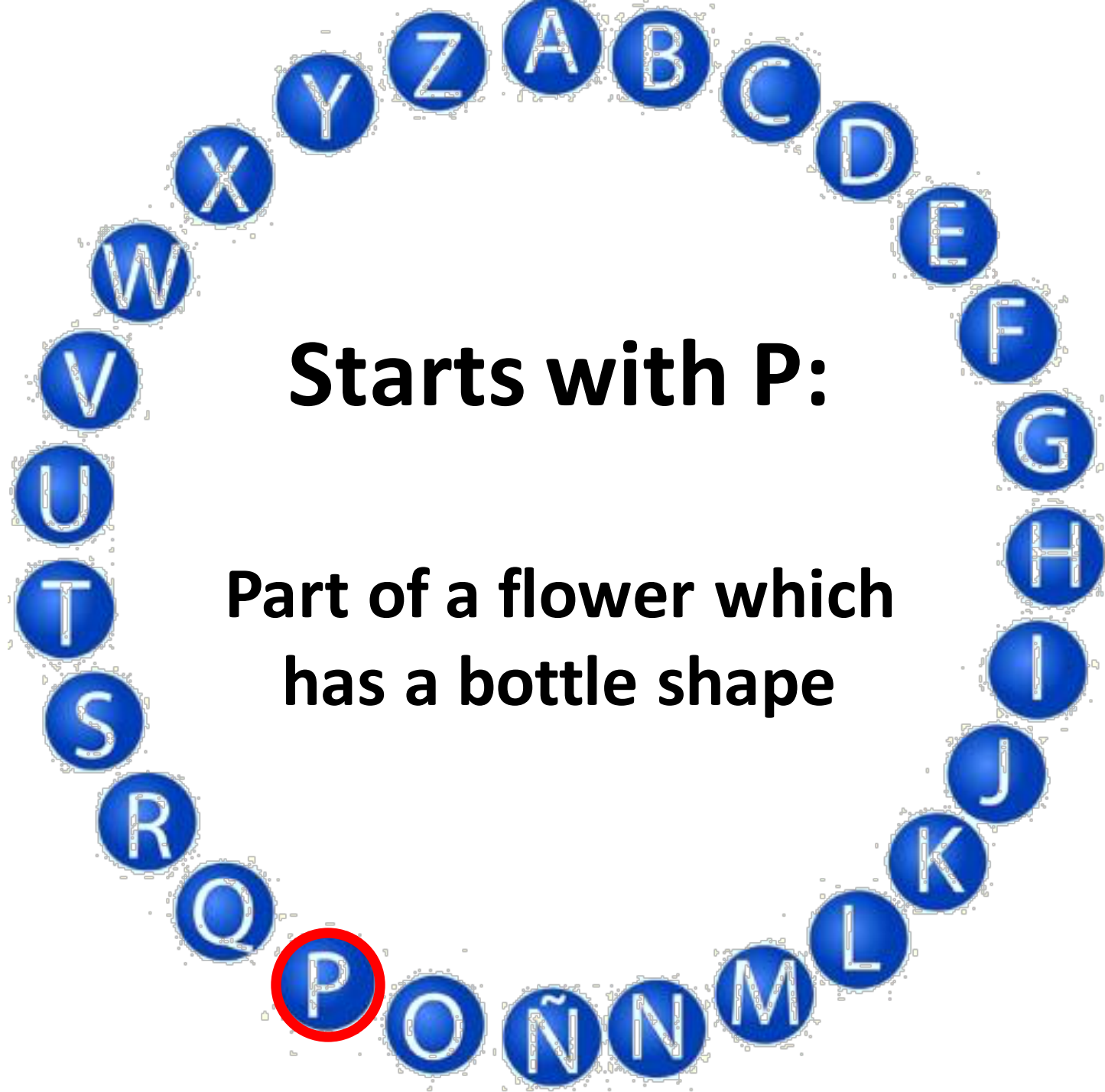




**Starts with O:**

a flower**



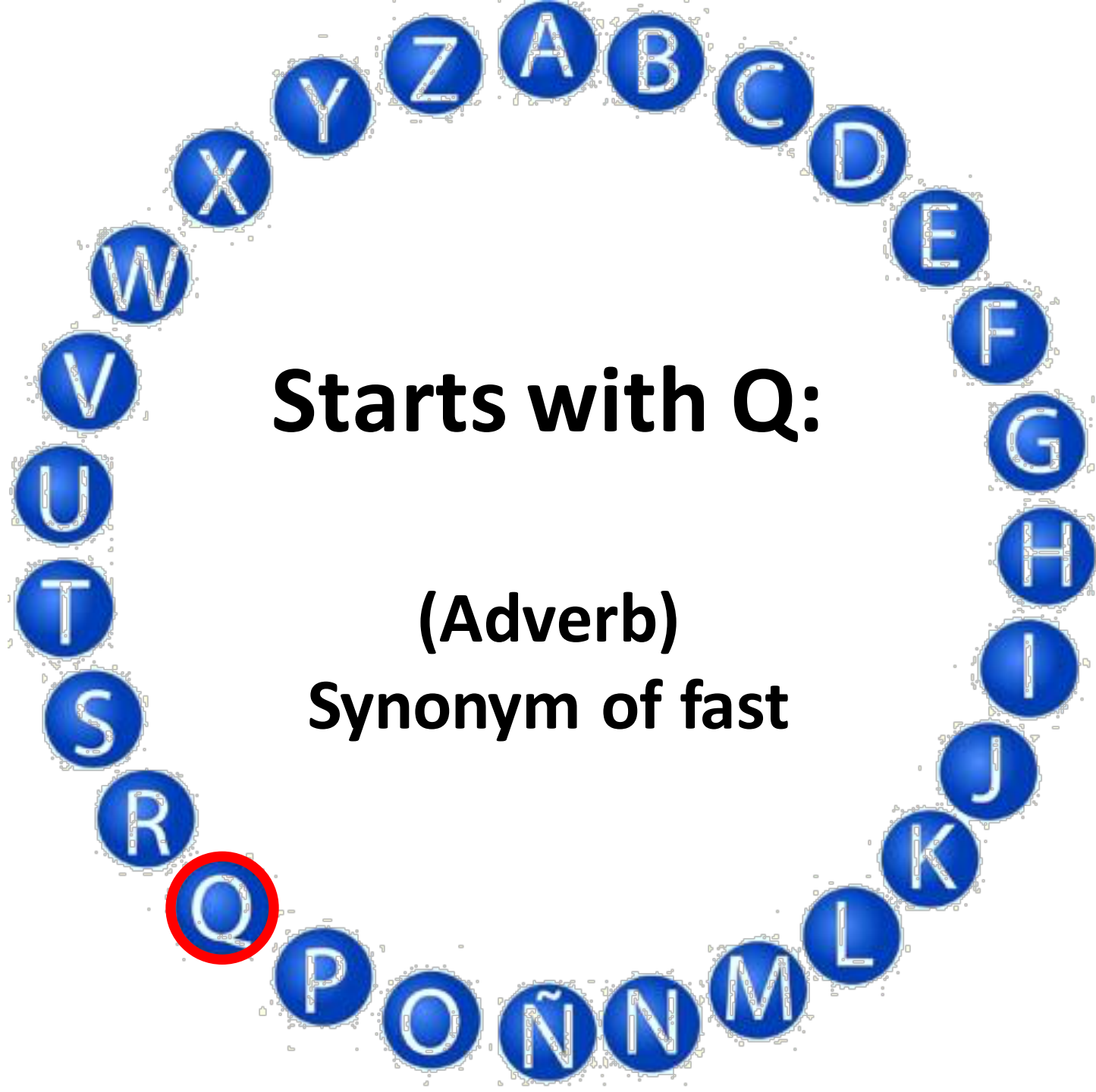


**Starts with P:**

has a bottle shape**



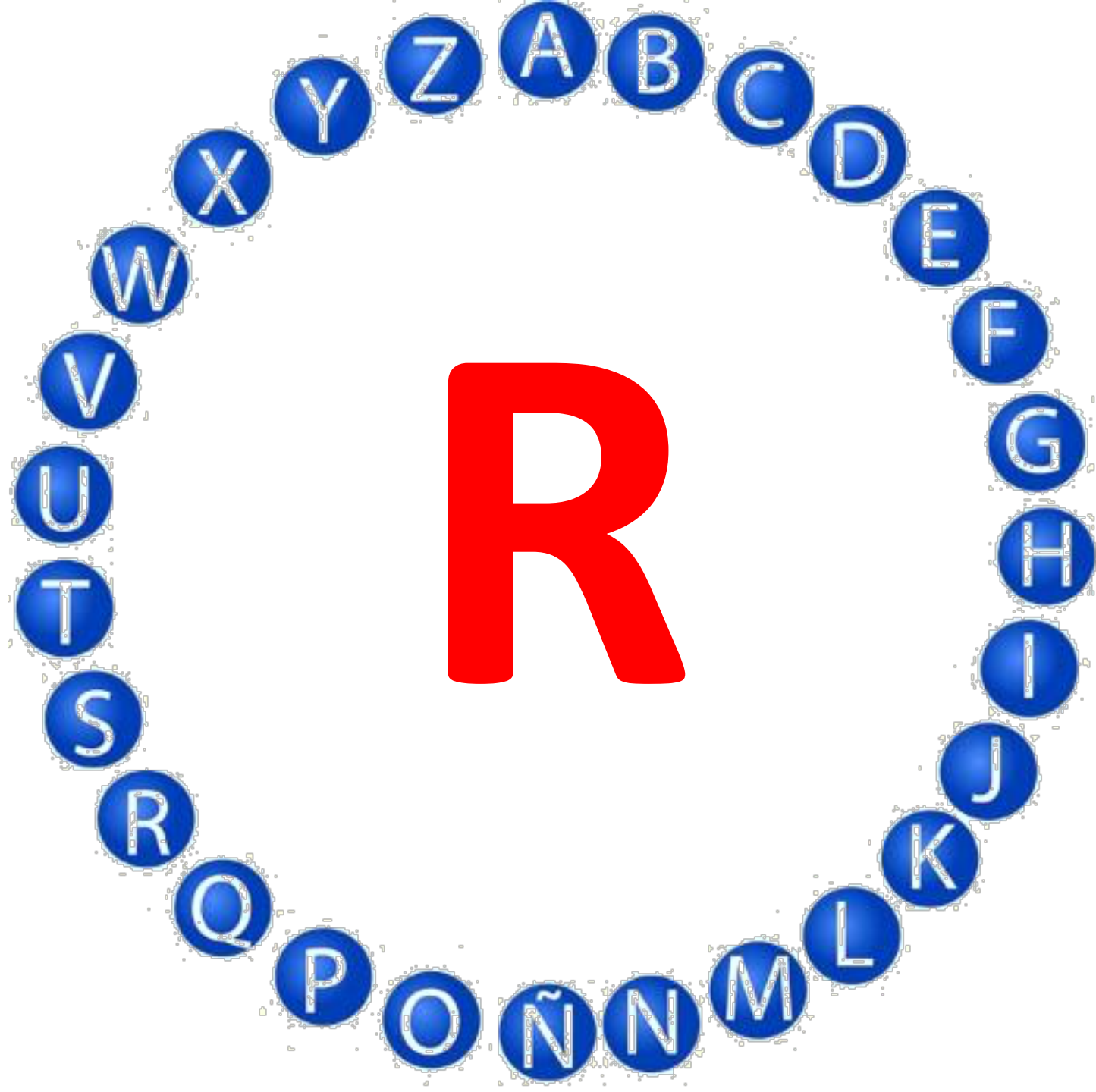




**Starts with Q:**

amount**

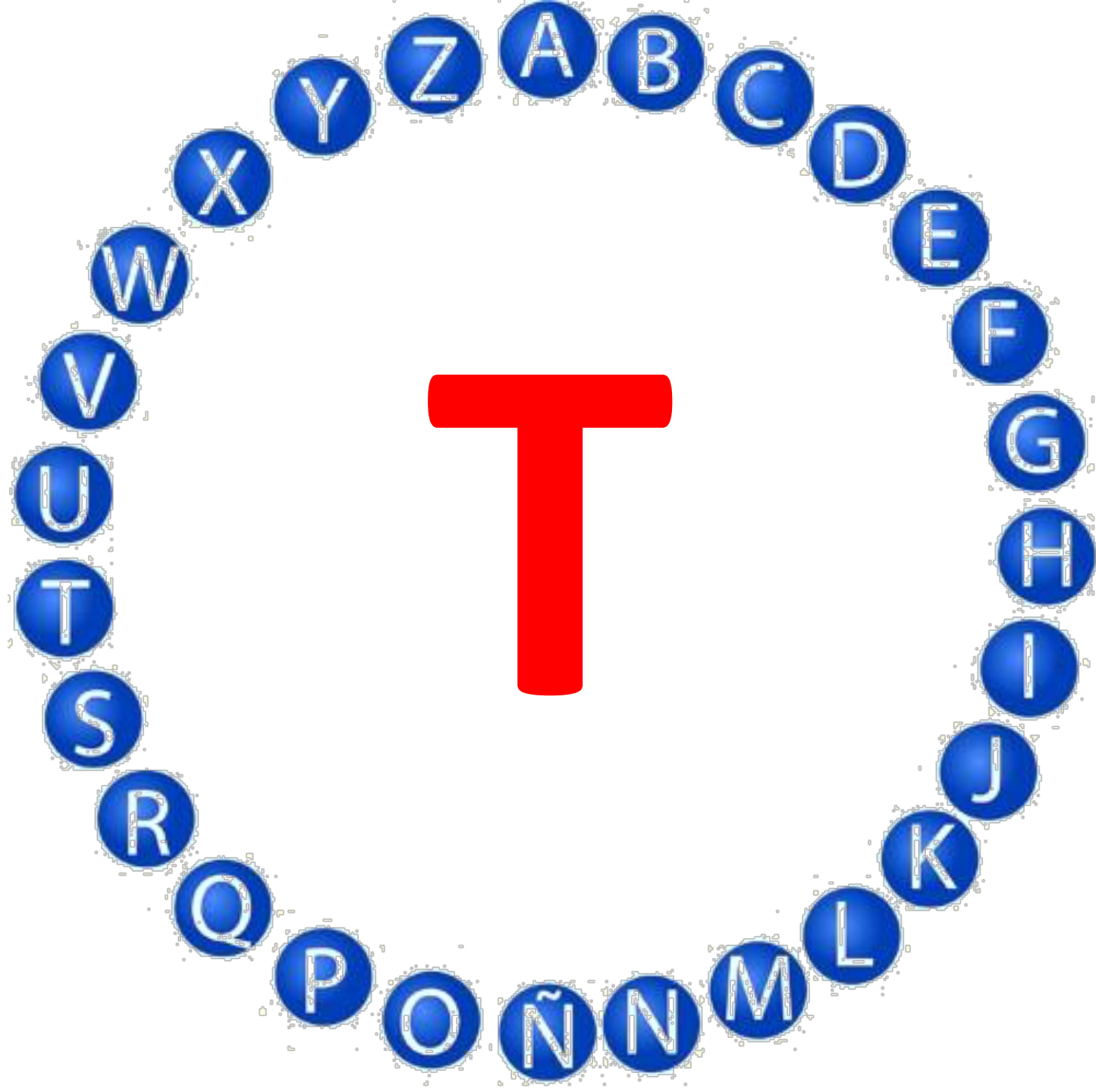


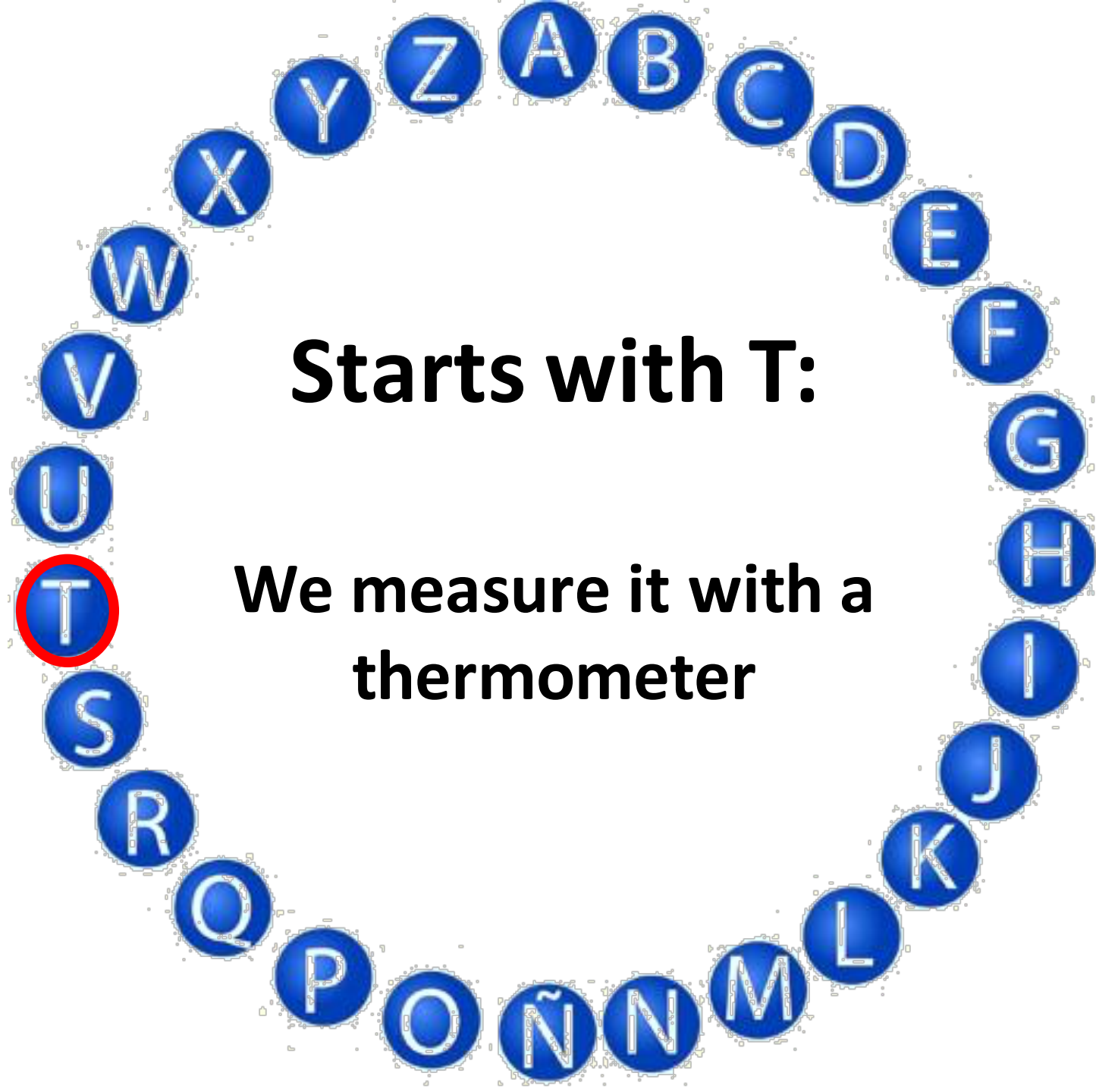




**Starts with S:**

thermometer**



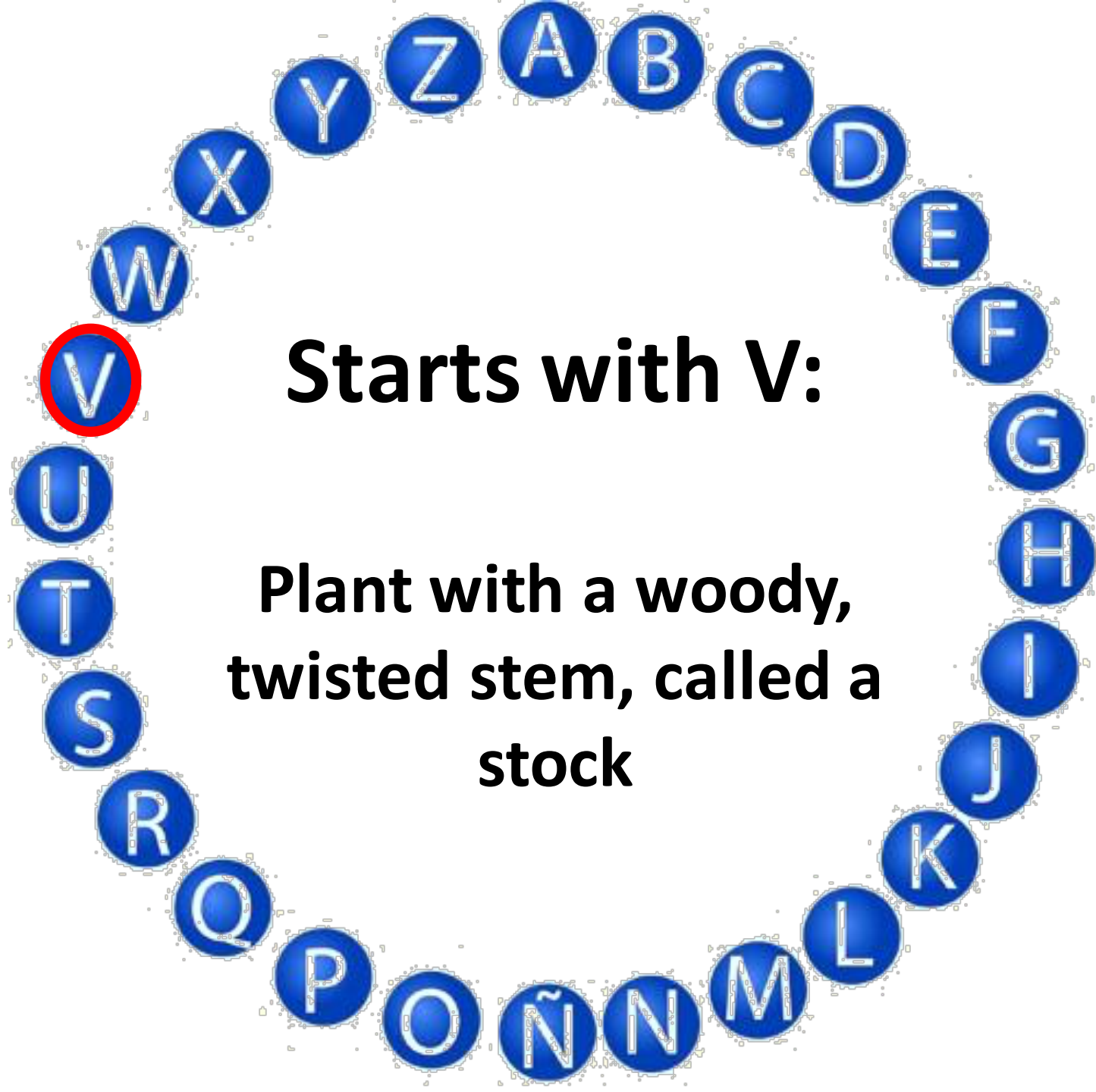


**Contains U:**

make flour**



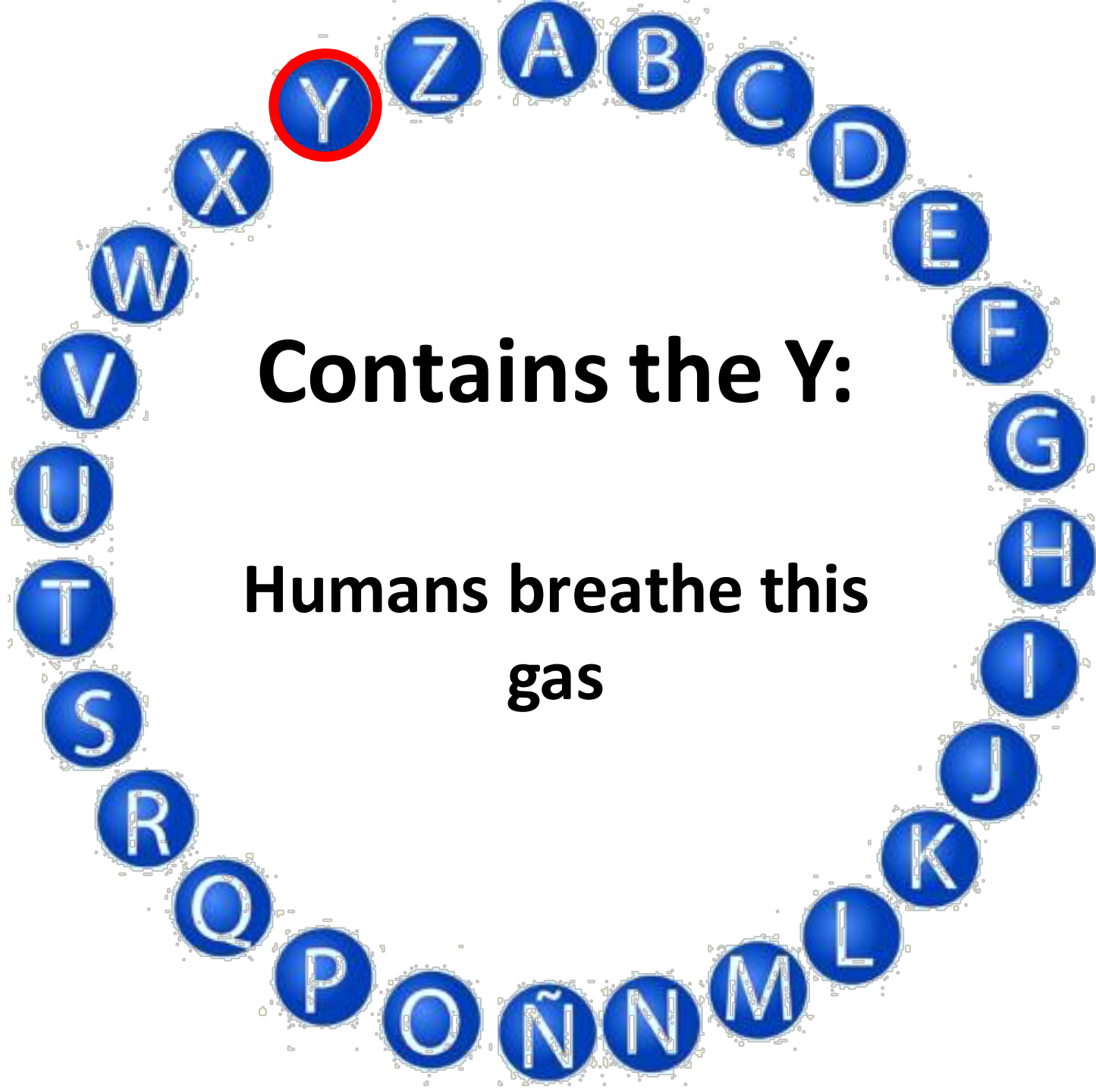




**Contains the X:**

leaves**

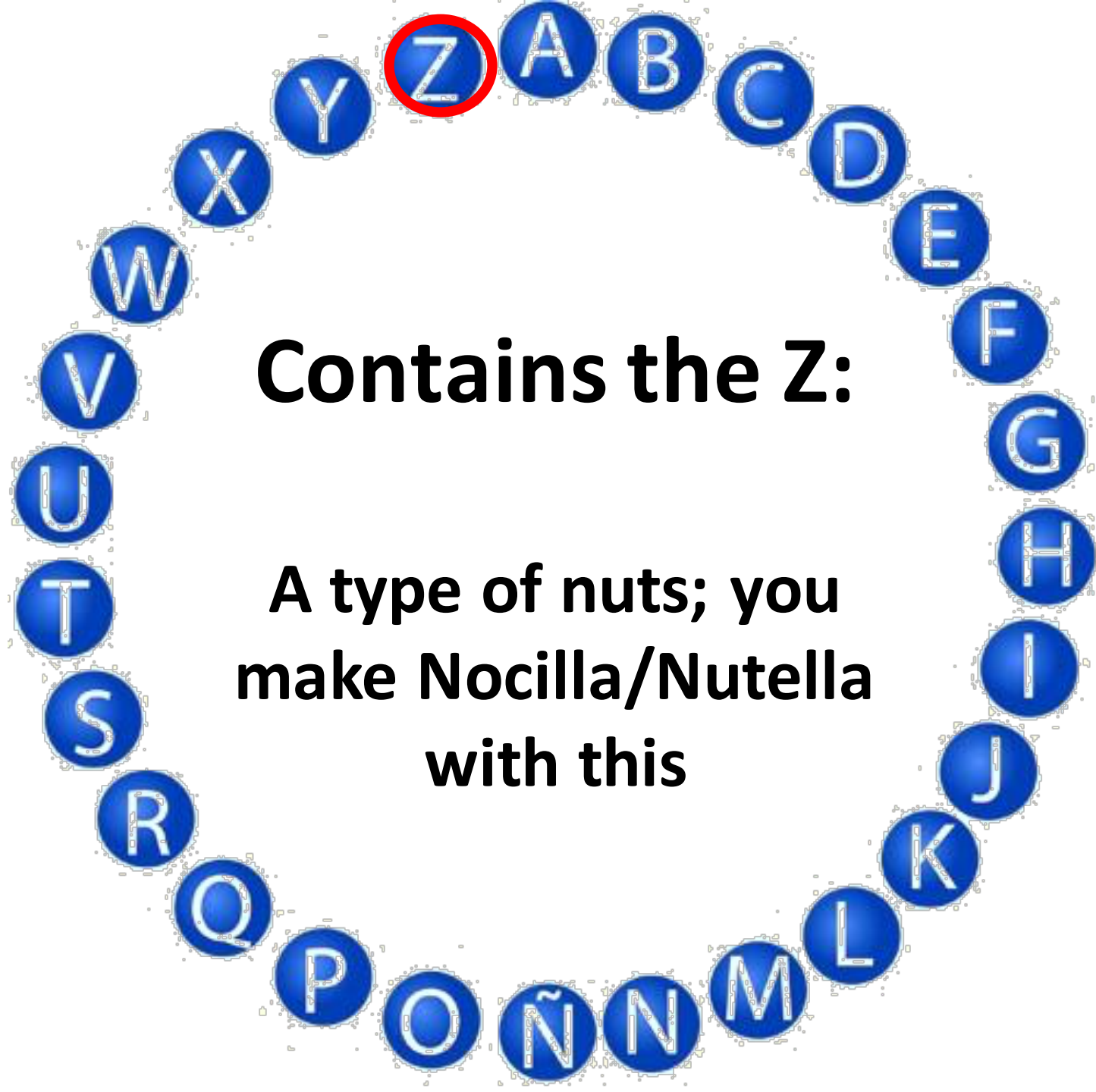




**Contains the Y:**
