# EQUIPMENT CHECK: THE PREDICTION TOOL

## Simple Future Tense (Positive)

### GRAMMAR RULE SCHEMATIC

We use **Simple Future** to talk about actions or events that **WILL** happen in the future.

**SUBJECT + WILL + BASE FORM OF THE VERB**



#### DATA SAMPLE 01

I will go to the park tomorrow.



#### DATA SAMPLE 02

She will visit her grandmother.

# EQUIPMENT CHECK: NEGATIVE READINGS

Simple Future Tense (Negative)

## GRAMMAR RULE SCHEMATIC

Use 'will not' (shortened to 'WON'T') after the subject to form negative sentences.

**Subject + WON'T + Base Form of the Verb**

### DATA SAMPLE 01



I won't eat ice cream before dinner.

### DATA SAMPLE 02



They won't travel during the holidays.

## GRAMMAR RULE SCHEMATIC

**WILL + Subject + Base Form of the Verb?**



### DATA SAMPLE 01 ?

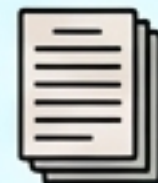
