

## PAST SIMPLE – NEGATIVE FORM

Recordad que durante el curso pasado y las primeras semanas del curso hemos trabajado el pasado simple en su forma afirmativa. En esta unidad vamos a trabajarlo en su forma negativa. Para ello lo más importante es recordar que hay que añadir el auxiliar “didn’t” y añadir el verbo en infinitivo. El error más típico es poner por ejemplo “I didn’t found a coin” cuando debería decirse “I didn’t find a coin”. A continuación tenéis el cuadro explicativo con ejemplos de verbos regulares e irregulares:
