NAME OF THE GAME/TASK : <i>Handkerchiefs</i>	
MAIN RULES <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Everybody wears a handkerchief on his or her side.• At the signal, everybody have to try to steel other's handkerchief.• The maximum amount of handkerchiefs anybody can take is 3.• The game lasts 2 minutes.	
MATERIAL NEEDED <ul style="list-style-type: none">• A big and wide place.• One handkerchief for every player.•	
BASIC PHYSICAL EDUCATION CONTENT INVOLVED IN <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Endurance• Agility•	
MAIN MOTORIC ACTIONS INVOLVED IN <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Speed reaction• Awareness• Dodge	
BASIC TEACHER'S LANGUAGE INVOLVED IN <ul style="list-style-type: none">• This game is called "Handkerchiefs" and it's played individually.• Everybody wears a handkerchief on her or his side.• When the teacher says "Go!" you have to try to steal other's handkerchiefs.• If you steal a handkerchief, you put it on your side. You can have 3 at the most.• When you are putting a handkerchief you stole, nobody can attack you.• The game will end up when I say "It's over!" and it will last around 2 minutes.	
BASIC PUPIL'S LANGUAGE INVOLVED IN <ul style="list-style-type: none">• I've got it! (<i>When somebody steals a handkerchief</i>)• You can't do it! (<i>If somebody tries to steal a handkerchief when you are putting on your side one you have stolen</i>).• I've got 1-2-3... (<i>When the teacher asks how many handkerchiefs you've got</i>)
