CIPFP Batoi, in Alcoi (Alicante) Spain

Introduction:

- CIPFP Batoi is a Further and Higher Education College.
- It is completely funded by the Valencian Regional Government, in Spain.
- It is <u>located</u> in <u>Alcoi</u>, a medium-size town with around 61,000 residents, between **Alicante** and **Valencia**.
- In January 2011, we moved to our **new** buildings with excellent facilities.
- In May 2015, we made this <u>lip dub</u>.
- This year 2017-2018: we are **126 teachers** and over **1,600 students**.



We offer courses in two levels:

- Further Education Courses for 16+.
 - Vocational Upper Secondary studies, **EQF** level 4 or **ISCED** level 453.
 - Students are **16+** years when they begin.
 - Access requires having finished the Compulsory Secondary Education.
 - Student mobilities can be funded by Erasmus+ for VET learners.
- . Higher Education Courses for 18+.
 - Short-cycle Higher Education, EQF level 5 or ISCED level 554.
 - Students are **18+** when they begin.
 - The "Spanish Baccalaureate" is required to have direct access.
 - Student mobilities can be funded by Erasmus+ for Higher Education.

In both cases, **mature students** can also gain entry. And some of our courses are also offered on a **semi-distance learning** basis.



Most courses are **2-year Full Time** with a total duration of **2000 hours**. They include **400-hour work placements** at the end of the 2nd year, usually **three months**, from early March to early June.

Our Erasmus+ Charter for Higher Education

- In 2009, we received the previous <u>Erasmus University Charter</u>.
- Since 2013, we have the new <u>Erasmus+ Charter for Higher Education</u> and organise <u>Student Mobilities for Traineeships</u> (or Work Placements) and <u>Staff Mobilities</u> for Training.
- Our main priority are <u>Student Mobilities for Traineeships</u> (or Placements):
 - Host organisations may be private companies and public organisations.
 - They don't have to pay students.
 - Students receive from the EU a grant of 400 €/month.
 - Our traineeships usually last 3 months, from early March to early June.

- Health & Environment.




