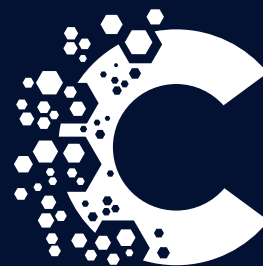

Student support services

CIPFP Canastell has a wide range of services available for the students that are designed to favour their academic, professional and personal development.

Career and educational guidance

CIPFP Canastell is a Benchmark Centre in the Alicante region of the OrientaFP education innovation programme that provides guidance on professions and education to help students plan their academic and professional careers.

Information about grants and scholarships

Through academic guidance, students are informed about the different grants and scholarships that are available. This information is also publicised on the centre's website, so it is easy for users to keep up-to-date.

Equality, coexistence and mediation

Preparation for the Spanish University Entrance Exam

Internationalisation

ERASMUS+ PROGRAMME

Studies show that spending some time abroad not only enriches students' academic and professional development, it also helps them acquire intercultural competences and autonomy.

Canastell sends about 50 students abroad each year to countries such as Portugal, Germany, Italy, Poland, Lithuania, the Netherlands, Norway, Malta, Austria and Ireland and its track record in KA1 projects is increasing.

Staff exchanges are also beneficial, for both the participants and the home and host institutions.

We have established partnerships for work placements with host centres in numerous European Union countries.

These work placements, funded through the Erasmus+ programme, are an excellent opportunity for Canastell students to broaden their cultural and educational experience while they complete their professional training. It is a unique learning experience that they can make the most of, because it helps them acquire skills and knowledge that they can later use in their academic and professional careers.

That is why, our centre values and actively promotes the improvements that Erasmus+ programmes make to our entire educational community.



Erasmus+





CIPFP Canastell actively takes part in the Erasmus+ programme, by providing both the students and the teaching staff with international experiences.

Students in the first and second year can take part in work placements in different European countries. As for the teaching staff, they can take part in teacher training programmes such as job shadowing and go to structured courses.

Mobility projects are organised in the following way:

- Intermediate Vocational Education Training, Basic Vocational Education Training and Basic Qualification Programmes: through our own KA122 programme and a consortium of educational centres.

- Higher Vocational Education Training: the centre has the ECHE (Erasmus Charter for Higher Education), which lets it manage higher education mobility projects independently.

KA120 Accreditation: the centre has applied for this accreditation so that it can organise its own Erasmus+ project, which will expand on the mobility opportunities for the whole educational community. For more information, please visit our website.



Emprén Programme



The Emprén Programme aims to promote entrepreneurial culture in all the Vocational Education Training centres, through the implementation of entrepreneurial endeavours and by setting up companies in public education centres of the Generalitat Valenciana (Regional Government of the Valencian Community).

It is intended to favour an entrepreneurial mindset in all the vocational education training centres, by using active teaching methodologies and enhancing aspects such as creativity, innovation and self-management among students enrolled in Intermediate and Higher Vocational Education Training programmes.

It gets students involved in the design and development of entrepreneurial projects that prepare them to set up their own business, which favour cooperation, solidarity, teamwork and a spirit of research and innovation, among other values.

At our centre we take part in projects such as the Cemex City Challenge, the Startup Programme, the University of Alicante Entrepreneurship Competition and the FUNDEUN Entrepreneurship Competition.

Innovatec



The Innovatec programme aims to implement digitalisation and technology applied to all areas of vocational education, as well as active methodologies, particularly project-based collaborative learning and other innovative models that together with the future technological trends to be incorporated into the production processes, improve the personal, social and professional competences, along with the lifelong skills of students from vocational education and training.

The ideal implementation of this programme involves designing a global, interdisciplinary curriculum that is expressed through a single competence-based programme that requires teaching coordination, which is integrated into project-based learning and non-fragmentation by modules, to give teamwork and cooperation a key role.

The main reason why CIPFP Canastell uses the Innovatec programme is because it makes it easier to work in an inter-modular way, to obtain a global vision of the profession, bringing workplace reality into the classroom, using active methodologies and by collaborating. It also favours digitalisation, which familiarises students with the new technologies that they might encounter in real work environments and the work through projects and challenges makes the teaching-learning process of the students as realistic as possible.

Llança't Project



Llança't is the new space of the CIPFP Canastell designed to support students who have completed their studies and want to start their own business.

It creates an incubation area in the centre, where specialised entrepreneurship training is provided to help develop business ideas, along with specialised mentoring for each project, with access to resources to help students expand on their ideas.

Participation gives former students the opportunity to work in a real business-creation environment, improve their entrepreneurial skills and build a network of contacts with companies and local stakeholders. In short, Llança't gives participants the chance to transform an idea into a real credible project and begin to grow professionally from day one.

Acredita Programme



The Acredita Programme of the Generalitat Valenciana is the official procedure to assess and recognise professional competences acquired through work experience or non-formal training.

Its purpose is to help individuals obtain partial, accumulable accreditation, which can later help them obtain Vocational Training qualifications or Professional Certificates. The process includes an advisory phase and an assessment phase.

At CIPFP Canastell, this programme is implemented through specific accreditation committees for each professional area, which is made up of duly qualified examiners and advisers. The centre has committees for the areas of Installation and Maintenance, Electricity and Electronics, Hospitality and Tourism, Transport and Vehicle Maintenance, Safety and the Environment.

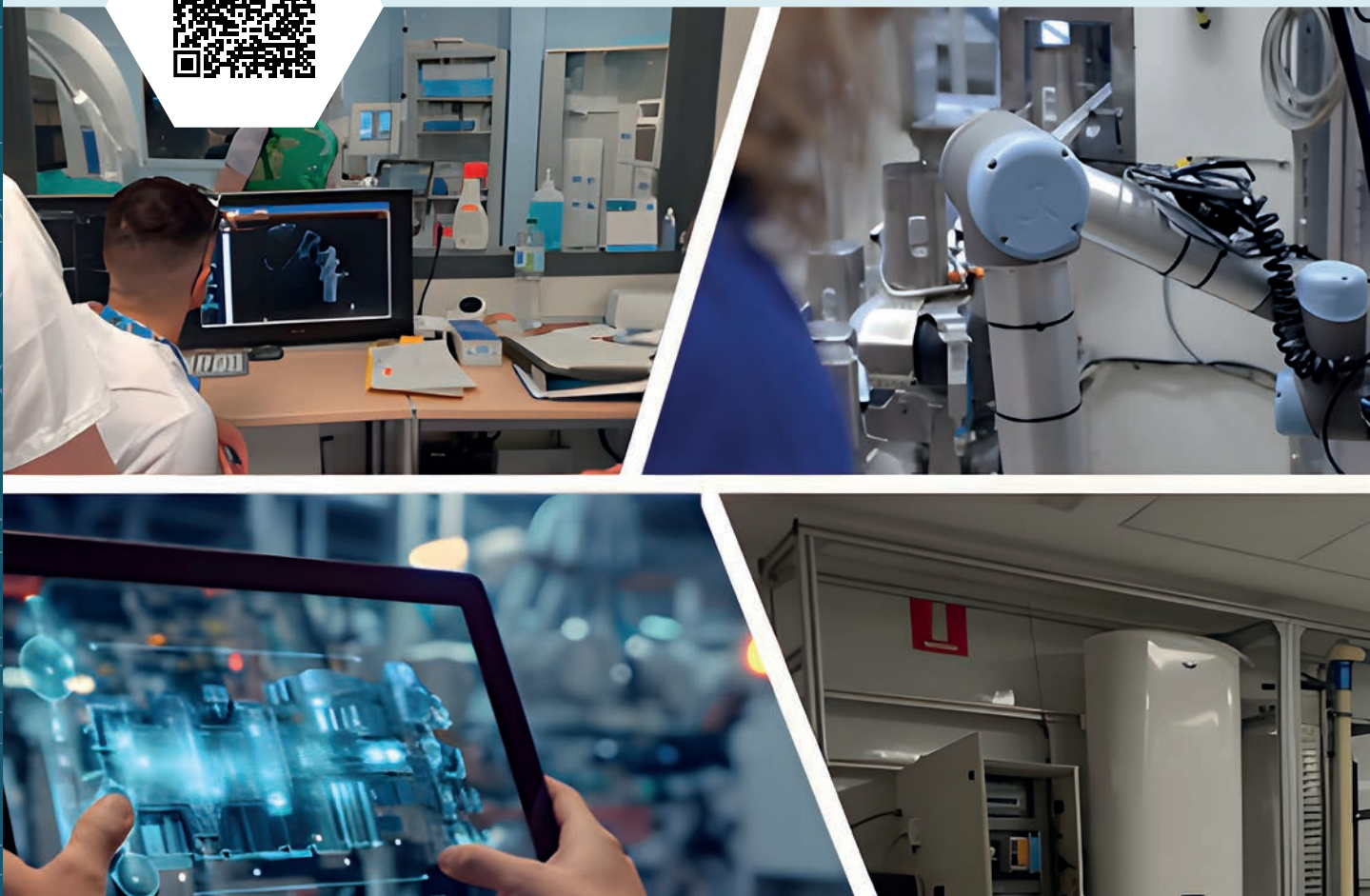


Innovation Projects

CIPFP Canastell is a benchmark in educational innovation in Vocational Education and Training, it covers different areas such as social inclusion, digital transformation, health, advanced industry and technical training.

Its collaborative approach with public and private entities, together with its participation in European projects and international networks, consolidates its commitment to high-quality, inclusive Vocational Education and Training that has been adapted to current and future challenges.

CIPFP Canastell has built up a collaboration network with the Ministry of Education and Vocational Training, the Generalitat Valenciana, CaixaBank Dualiza, Fundación Hefame, OEI, Fundeun, public hospitals, national and international Vocational Education and Training centres and technology companies, so it can promote a wide variety of projects, from inclusion and accessibility to advanced industry, healthcare and educational digitalisation.

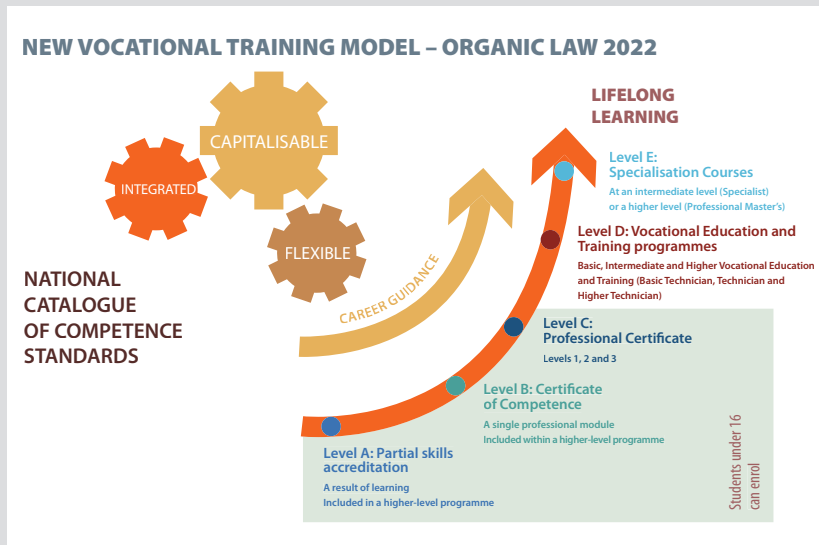
Not only do these championships showcase our students' talent, they promote personal achievement, technical innovation and direct connections with the business world.

CIPFP Canastell is firmly committed to taking part in these competitions, it supports its students with specific training, expert tutoring and collaboration with companies in the sector. This commitment has led to increasing participation and results that consolidate the centre as a regional benchmark.

These achievements are the result of the efforts of both students and teaching staff and they convey the centre's commitment to comprehensive, practical and high-quality training.

We have been awarded numerous medals: some of our students have represented the Valencian Community in the national SpainSkills championship and Spain at WorldSkills and EuroSkills, taking the name of Canastell and Valencian VET to a new level.

Why study at Canastell?



CIPFP Canastell is a benchmark Vocational Training centre, **it provides comprehensive training that adapts to the real needs** of students and the labour market, with access to all levels of the Vocational Education and Training system.

Level A – Partial Skills Accreditation.

Through the Acredita programme (procedures to assess and demonstrate professional competences), you can get your work experience or non-formal training officially recognised. This allows you to progress towards full qualifications based on your previous experience and get competence units of a training programme officially recognised.

CIPFP Canastell has committees that help people with work experience get their professional skills officially recognised.

We currently have five committees in the following professional areas:

- Electricity and Electronics.
- Safety and Environment.
- Hospitality and Tourism.
- Installation and Maintenance.
- Transport and Vehicle Maintenance.

Level B – Certificates of Competence

Training focused on immediate employability, it is very useful to update your professional profile or to get into the labour market with new, specific skills. It certifies a set of professional skills related to a specific area.

Level C – Professional Certificate

Designed for young people who need a more practical and motivating alternative. It provides initial technical training and it makes it easier to access Intermediate Vocational Education and Training programmes or directly get into the labour market.

It certifies a broader set of competences, equivalent to a professional certificate.

Level D – Basic, Intermediate and Higher Vocational Education and Training

These programmes provide solid technical training, combining theory with work experience in companies. They are ideal to access skilled jobs or to continue on to a higher level of Vocational Education and Training, specialisation courses or university studies, as appropriate.

Level E – Specialisation Courses

Qualifications with a higher level of technical skill and responsibility, which help participants access university studies or enhance specialisation through higher level courses.

Adapted Basic Qualification Training Programmes (People with functional diversity)

Our programmes are designed for young people with mild intellectual disabilities who want to continue their education. They provide official, practical and adapted training, with the dual objective of promoting personal development and improving employment opportunities.

The training combines Level I professional modules, which focuses on a specific professional profile, with

general education modules that consolidate basic skills such as communication, mathematics and personal autonomy.

Installation and Maintenance

Studying any of the programmes in the Installation and Maintenance professional area helps students acquire technical and practical competences in the installation, maintenance and repair of industrial and domestic equipment, systems and machinery.

There are two main areas: Thermal Installations and Maintenance, Air-Conditioning and Fluids, where

students develop the skills required in electricity, electronics, air-conditioning, plumbing, heating, industrial and commercial refrigeration; and Industrial Maintenance and Automation, where students acquire the competences needed in electricity, electronics, industrial maintenance and the control of automated systems, combining theory with hands-on training in specialised workshops.

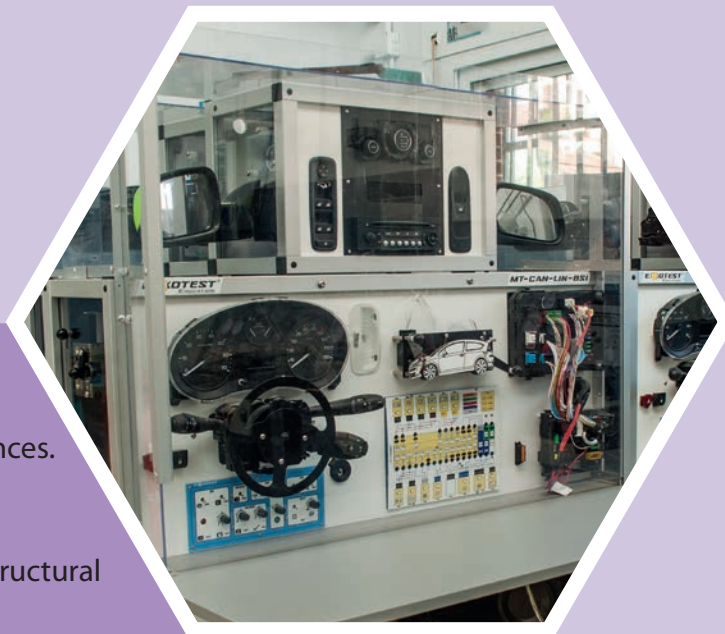
Transport and Vehicle Maintenance

The high demand for these studies conveys the potential and growing interest in this professional field.

Studying at CIPFP Canastell helps students acquire technical and practical skills in vehicle repair, maintenance, electricity and electronics, as well as vehicle servicing garage management and customer service.

The training is always updated to keep up with technological advances in the sector, particularly in electric and hybrid vehicles.

These programmes open the door both to **immediate employment** and the possibility of continuing to higher levels of education.



Access to University from Vocational Education and Training

Graduates of Higher Vocational Education and Training programmes (CFGS) gain direct access to study official university degrees. This is an alternative to the traditional Spanish university entrance exam (PAU/EBAU).

Direct access

- You must have the corresponding Higher Technician diploma.
- Vocational Education and Training graduates can apply for a university place without having to sit the general university entrance exam.
- The admission grade is calculated from the overall average mark of the Higher Vocational Education and Training programme (out of 10).

Improving the admission grade through the specific phase

- Although access into university is possible using only the average mark of the programme, many university degrees require a cut-off grade higher than 10. To increase their admission grade, students can voluntarily sit the specific phase of the Spanish university entrance exam (PAU), which:
- Allows students to take up to four subjects linked to the field of the desired degree.
- Each subject that is passed contributes up to 2 additional points, to get a maximum admission grade of 14.

Allocation of places and cut-off grades

Universities allocate places according to the admission grade and the number of applications. The cut-off grade is not fixed, it varies each year depending on the supply and demand. For certain degrees that are in high demand (Medicine, Nursing, Education, etc.), the admission grade normally has to be improved through the specific phase.

Credit recognition and validation

In many cases, when accessing a university degree related to the completed Vocational Education and Training programme, it is possible to ask for the subjects/credits to be recognised officially.

Each university sets its own recognition criteria based on its curricula, but basic training credits and, in some cases, more specialised subjects are often recognised.

Public universities in the Valencian Community have an agreement with the Regional Ministry of Education to recognise up to 30 ECTS credits in certain degrees for students coming from related Higher Vocational Education and Training VET programmes.

When choosing subjects of the specific phase, it is worthwhile selecting those that are most closely related to the desired degree, as they carry a higher weighting (0.1 or 0.2 depending on the field).

Universities publish their pre-enrolment and registration periods every year, the weighting tables published by each autonomous community and each university should always be checked. This increasingly more popular admission route provides Vocational Education and Training graduates with a real and competitive alternative to get into university and continue their academic and professional development.

University graduates who have had Vocational Education and Training are highly qualified professionals, with good technical skills and also well-developed soft skills, which is favoured by dual training and work-based learning.



Vocational Education and Training Admission Process

The admission process is regulated by the Regional Ministry of Education. Between April and May, the Resolution, instructions and calendar for admission are published.

Training in Companies



+ information

- There is a job bank available for students and companies.
- Training is shared between the centre and the company, the hours spent in the company are curricular.
- There is a joint assessment and a tutor is appointed in the school and another one in the company.

General Dual Training:

- Students over 16 can take part in the training in companies.
- Basic Vocational Education and Training students complete 400 hours of training in the company between the first and second year.
- Intermediate and Higher Vocational Education and Training students complete a minimum of 500 hours.
- We work with leading partner companies in the seven professional areas taught at Canastell.
- This training is not remunerated, but it is compatible with receiving a grant or financial aid.
- The Directorate-General for Vocational Education and Training deals with the registration in the Social Security System.

Intensive Dual Training:

- Students over 16 can take part in the training in companies.
- Basic, Intermediate and Higher Vocational Education and Training students complete between 700 and 1000 hours of training in the company over the two years.
- An increasing number of companies are interested in attracting talent through Intensive Dual Training.
- Students sign a Work-Training Contract or a Grant/ Scholarship Contract and training hours are paid.
- The company deals with the registration in the Social Security system and it is responsible for paying for these hours.



CIPFP Canastell Careers Information and Guidance Office

The Information and Careers Guidance Office of CIPFP Canastell is an online service (via email and telephone) and there is also an in-person service that is available for all users, not only the students at our centre, who need information or educational or professional guidance, which among other things helps them to:

- Make better decisions regarding their education and career.
- Learn about the current Vocational Education and Training available and the admission requirements.
- Find out about the different transfer options between educational stages.
- Understand professional profiles, their characteristics and opportunities focused on employability.
- Receive guidance on competence accreditation procedures based on previous work experience or non-formal training.
