The Roman Empire began over 2000 years ago. During their empire, the Romans ruled most of Western Europe, including England and Wales (Britannia) and Spain (Hispania). All Roman towns had a wall and long, straight roads.

Roman towns usually had two main roads, one in a north-south direction, and one in a west-east direction. The two main roads met at the crossroads. Close to the crossroads, there was an open square called the forum. In the forum there were usually shops, markets and government offices.

An aqueduct brought water into the town from rivers. Rich people lived in large houses outside the town. They had their own water supply. Poor people lived in apartments in the town center. They got their water from public fountains. The bath house was for bathing and exercise. It was also a social meeting place. Some bath houses had restaurants, game rooms, cafés and libraries.
