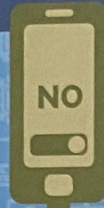




Think about the content you post!

Is it about you? Are you the subject?



Check with the subject **BEFORE** you post any content. Think about how you would feel if someone posted content about you **without asking first**.



You should **respect** their wishes and not publish the content unless they are happy for you to do so. Consider the **consequences** of going against what they want. How would you **feel** if you were in the same situation?



Have you checked with **the subject of the photo** or content to see if they are happy for it to be published?



Are they **happy** for you to go ahead and publish the content?



Go ahead and publish the content. Remember that it is good practice to **always check** with others before you post content about them.



Okay - go ahead and publish the content.



Think carefully about whether you really want to post this content. Should you think about making use of **privacy settings** so that you are in **control** of who can see it?



Could it be **misinterpreted** or **misunderstood**?



Go ahead and publish the content. Always remember that others can **capture content** – e.g. take screen shots or repurpose it somehow.
