

Stanisław Wyspiański

Stanisław Wyspiański was a Polish playwright, painter and poet, as well as interior and furniture designer. Being a patriotic writer, he created a series of symbolic and national dramas within the artistic philosophy of the Young Poland Movement.

In 2007, after fifteen years of its existence, the school received Stanisław Wyspiański's name. Since 2003, the school also has had its own anthem.

Secondary School Certificate

In our high school as in other schools, in order to get the secondary school certificate the final exam has to be passed. Students must take it in obligatory subjects: Polish, Mathematics and Foreign Language.

In addition, at least one exam in a chosen optional subject on the extended level is obligatory.

The vast majority of our students pass this exam very well.

Class profiles

Legal and police class

Students learn about the legal acts in force, the judicial authorities, the rules of service and legal protection.

An additional subject is self-defense and intervention techniques led by a martial arts instructor. As part of the project, the legal and police group also undergoes shooting training.



Bio-medical class

Laboratory classes in biology and chemistry are carried out in cooperation with universities. An additional subject is medical rescue, which is included in the recruitment process for medical faculties and for fire and police schools. In addition, eager students can deepen their medical knowledge during classes in the First Aid Team operating at school.



Theater Meandry

Our theatre called “Meanders” gives many performances. Theatre succeeds a lot through the hard work of actors.

The team has been operating since 2008 and the main goal of it is learning how to save human life and propagating this knowledge not only among students.



Sailing team


The first sailing cruise took place in 2007, however officially the team started its activity in 2011. Its aim is to popularize and promote sailing and canoeing. The sailing team gathers lovers of shanties and sails, organizes meetings with trainers and sailing instructors and prepares for examinations for the degree of yacht sailor, and during the summer organizes cruises on the Great Masurian Lakes route.



Blood donor club

Every year in grade 12, the teacher coordinator - Lidia Leciejewska conducts recruitment of honorary blood donors. Currently, the blood donation takes place in "Bloodbus" which comes to our city.

Several times our Club has been involved in spontaneous collection of blood for those in need.



Volunteering club

It was created in March 2018.

The aim of the Volunteer Club is to give disinterested help to disabled children and teenagers by high school students.

The club has regularly participated in nationwide social assistance campaigns organized and implemented via the Internet during Christmas. For this activity our school received the Certificate of the Socially Engaged School.





Our school participates in many Erasmus+ projects. In June 2018 we completed the project called **“Reversed Roles at School: Flipped Classroom and Learning Through Teaching.”** The partners schools were from: Italy, Greece, Turkey, Romania, Hungary and Lithuania. The idea of this method is very simple: the traditional lesson model is upside down, we begin a lesson with homework. The main purpose of the homework is to prepare for what will be in the classroom.

This year we have as many as 3 projects from Erasmus+:
