is a town located near Valencia, on Spain's beautiful Mediterranean coast.

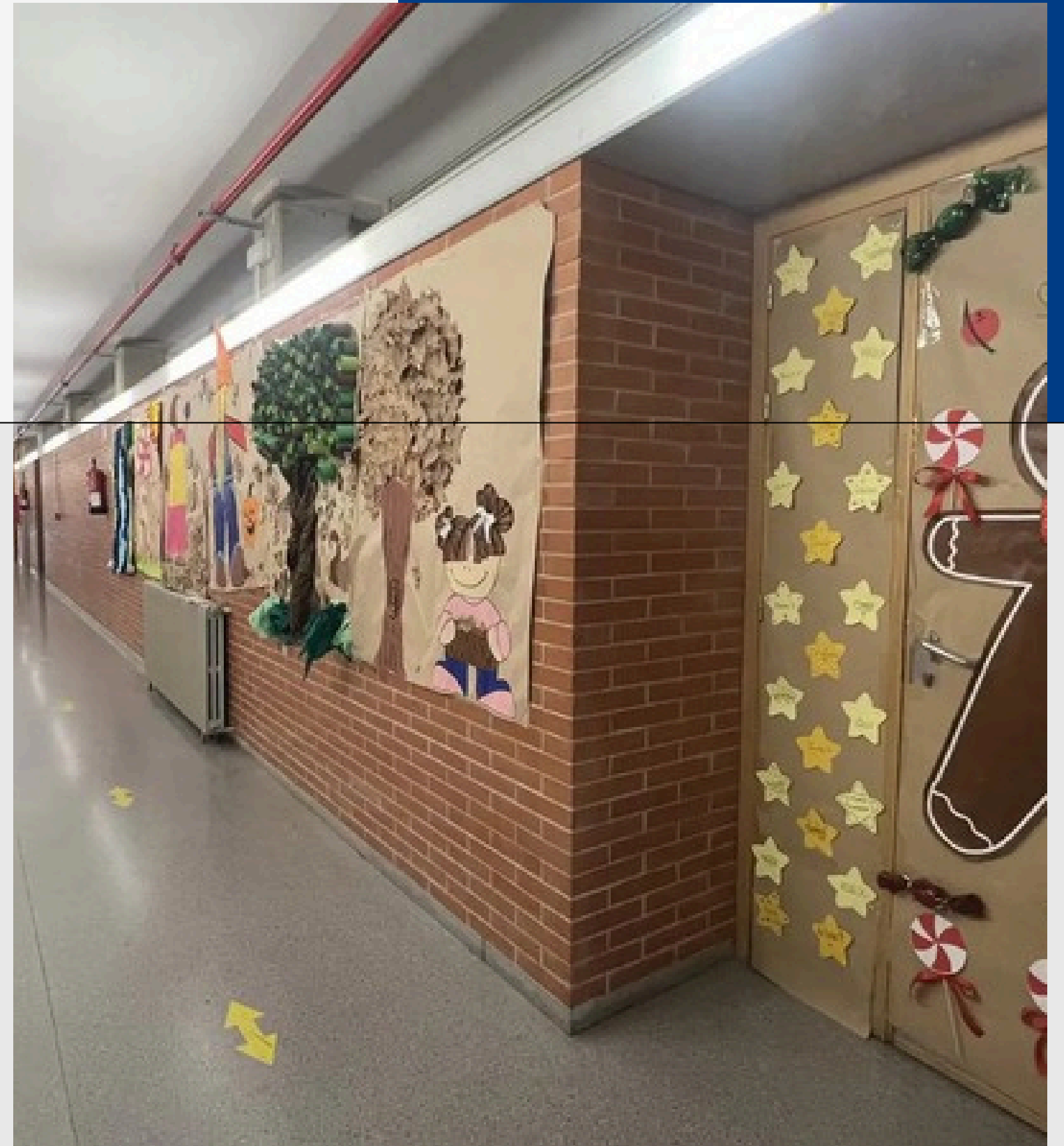
# OUR SCHOOL

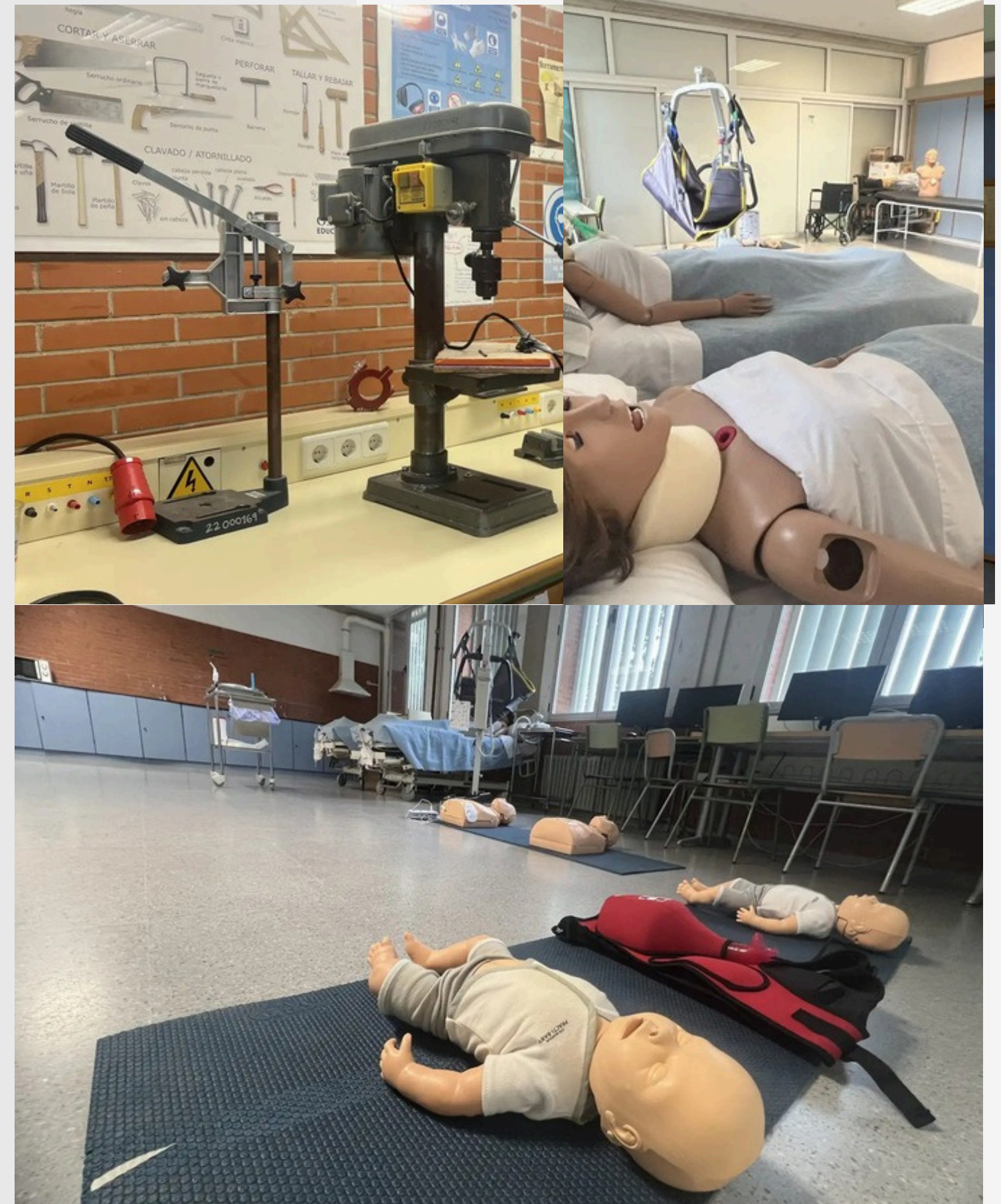

## CITY OF ARTS & SCIENCES

Futuristic complex with science museum, opera house and aquarium, made by Calatrava.



## VALENCIA CATHEDRAL & EL MIGUELETE

Gothic cathedral home with the iconic octagonal bell tower El Miguelete.



## LA LONJA DE LA SEDA

UNESCO World Heritage Site. A masterpiece of Gothic civil architecture and former silk exchange.



# VALENCIA & ITS LANDMARKS



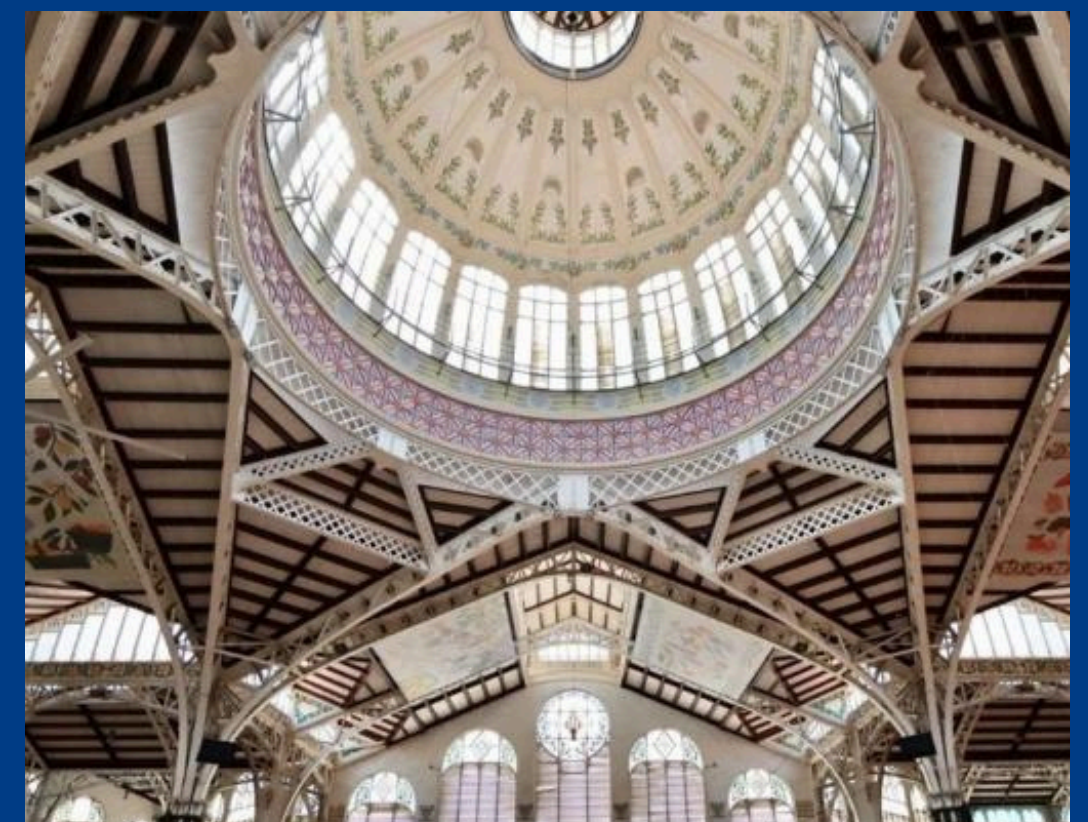
## TORRES DE SERRANO

The Serranos Towers are one of the best-preserved medieval city gates in Europe. Built in the 14th century, they were part of Valencia's ancient defensive walls.



## TORRES DE QUART

The Quart Towers are impressive medieval gates that once protected the city from attacks. Their walls still show marks from cannon fire during historical battles.



## MERCADO CENTRAL

Valencia's Central Market is one of the largest and oldest fresh food markets in Europe. Its modernist architecture and wide variety of local products make it a major city attraction.





## **LAS FALLAS VALENCIA'S MOST IMPORTANT FESTIVAL**

UNESCO Intangible Cultural Heritage since 2016.  
Celebrated March 15-19 every year, Las Fallas fills  
Valencia with spectacular hand-crafted monuments  
(ninots), fireworks, and the iconic mascletà.



# VALENCIAN GASTRONOMY

Valencian cuisine is one of the richest in Spain, deeply rooted in Mediterranean tradition. Based on rice, almonds, and local agricultural products, it reflects centuries of cultural heritage.



## PAELLA VALENCIANA

The iconic rice dish with chicken, rabbit and vegetables. Culinary symbol of Valencia.



## FIDEUÀ

Similar to paella but made with thin pasta and fresh prawns.



## HORCHATA & SWEETS

Refreshing horchata with fartons



# VALENCIAN GASTRONOMY



## PELADILLAS

Peladillas are traditional sweets made from almonds coated with a hard layer of sugar.



## TURRÓN DE JIJONA

Turrón de Jijona is a soft nougat made from ground almonds, honey, sugar, and egg whites. It is one of the most famous traditional sweets in the Valencia region.



## ARROZ AL HORNO

Arroz al Horno is a traditional Valencian baked rice dish prepared with pork, chickpeas, potatoes, and tomatoes. It is cooked in a clay pot and is a popular family meal.



# LANGUAGES IN OUR REGION

Our region of Valencia is officially bilingual. Both Spanish and Valencian are co-official languages used in education, public life and daily communication. Bilingual education reflects our cultural identity and prepares students for a diverse and interconnected Europe.



## SPANISH

The national language of Spain, used widely in education, media and public administration across the country.



## VALENCIAN

A Romance language co-official in the Valencian Region, integral to local culture, identity and bilingual schooling.
