



INFORMATION ABOUT XARXA LIBRES FOR NOUINGUTS

Newly arrived students who have not yet mastered the vehicular languages are exempt from assessment during the first six months from their arrival in the Valencian Community. After this period, such students must be assessed on all subjects and the necessary adaptation measures must be applied in order to facilitate the acquisition of knowledge on each subject. For this reason, we recommend these students to participate in the *Xarxa de Llibres* program when that time comes, as it will allow them to have free access to textbooks for all subjects and subsequent courses.

WHAT IS XARXA DE LLIBRES?

It is a textbook bank that allows students free access to all the books they will need throughout their time in Compulsory Secondary Education (ESO) and Baccalaureate.

HOW TO PARTICIPATE IN XARXA DE LLIBRES?

To participate in *Xarxa de Llibres* it is necessary to provide a set of books from the current course in which you are enrolled. You can check the list of books on the notice board at the center's hall. The set of books must be delivered at the end of the course when requested. Once you deliver your set at the end of the course, you will begin to become part of the program and so you will be provided with the books for the following courses free of charge.

If any student has an unfavorable economic situation that prevents them from purchasing the initial set of books, they must go to the Social Services office in the town where they live and request a report proving this. By providing this report to the institute, the books will be supplied to students for free.

RULES FOR USE OF XARXA DE LLIBRES BOOKS

- Books should not be written on or scratched.
- They must be returned at the end of the course in the same conditions in which they were borrowed.
- The student must cover the books that have been lent to them if they are not already covered and place the labels provided by the center with their name and surname.
- They must be responsible for taking care of all the books in the lot, because if the student loses any, they will have to replace them.
