Lo primero que tenéis es una serie de tarjetas de vocabulario. Leedlas atentamente.

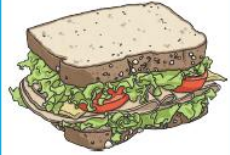
Después, encontráis un menú de un restaurante.

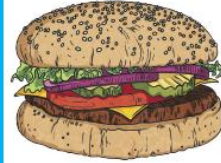

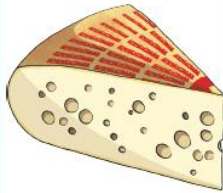

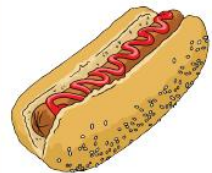
